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I. Installation Requirements

Before you begin - To install **EAOR Version 2022-1** on your computer, you must have Administrator rights. If you do not have Administrator rights on your machine, or if you are not sure what this means, contact your System Administrator for assistance. You may also need an Internet connection during installation if your computer does not have the software needed by EAOR. This Internet connection is used by the installation process to retrieve software needed by EAOR Version 2022-1. It is recommended that you close all other applications during this installation.

Minimum System Requirements - This section describes the minimum configuration requirements for a computer where EAOR Version 2022-1 is to be installed. If the minimum requirements are not met, EAOR Version 2022-1 setup will block the installation of the redistributable package. Specifically, note that you cannot install the .NET Framework on a computer running the Microsoft Windows 10 operating system (On Windows 8 and above, the .NET Framework is an operating system component and cannot be independently Uninstalled).

Required software - EAOR Version 2022-1 uses the Microsoft Data Access Component (MDAC) 2.8 SP1 or later and the .NET Frameworks **4.5.1/4.5.2**.

- MDAC allows programs to use the Access database and is required for EAOR Version 2022-1 to work correctly. Please see Appendix A for installing **MDAC** and Appendix H for **MS Access Driver**.
- The Microsoft .NET Framework is a component of the Microsoft Windows® operating system used to build and run Windows-based applications. If the version of this software is not on your computer, the setup process will use your connection to the Internet to install it for you. Please see Appendix B for more information about the .NET Framework updates.

Operating System Requirements - To install EAOR Version 2022-1, you must have one of the following operating systems with Microsoft Internet Explorer 5.5 or later installed on your computer:

- Microsoft Windows 2008/2012 Server, service pack and critical updates available from the Microsoft Security Web site (<https://www.microsoft.com/en-us/download/details.aspx?id=5842>)
- Microsoft Windows 7/8/10/11.

Hardware Requirements - The minimum hardware requirements include:

- Central Processing Unit (CPU) Intel Pentium core i3, 2.4 GHZ or the minimum CPU required for running the operating system, whichever is higher.
- Random Access Memory (RAM) 4 GB or the minimum RAM required for running the operating system, whichever is higher.
- Hard Drive with 400 MB of free space.
- USB Flash Driver or CD standard disk drive (for submitting/importing/exporting data). This is optional if you have an Internet connection.
- Conventional Mouse or other pointing device.

Network Installation – Please see Appendix C for instructions on how to install EAOR for multiple computers on a network.

Appendix B – Microsoft .NET Framework 4.5.1/4.5.2

1. The .Net Frameworks 4.5.1/4.4.2 may need to be installed on PCs running Windows 7. If you are running the Windows 8/10 operating system .Net Framework 4.6 as on OS Component and we cannot install this .Net Framework.



If you're using the Windows operating system, the .NET Framework may already be installed on your computer. In addition, if you install an app that requires the .NET Framework, the app's setup program might install a specific version of the .NET Framework on your computer. In some cases, you may see a dialog box that asks you to install the .NET Framework. If you've just tried to run an app when this dialog box appears and if your computer has Internet access, you can go to a webpage that lets you install the missing version of the .NET Framework. For more information, see the [Installation guide](#).

In general, you shouldn't uninstall versions of the .NET Framework that are installed on your computer. There are two reasons for this:

- If an app that you use depends on a specific version of the .NET Framework, that app may break if that version is removed.

- Some versions of the .NET Framework are in-place updates to earlier versions. For example, the .NET Framework 3.5 is an in-place update to version 2.0, and the .NET Framework 4.8 is an in-place update to versions 4 through 4.7.2.
