## I. Installation Requirements

**Before you begin** - To install EAOR Reviewer Version 2018-1 on your computer, you must have **Administrator** rights. If you do not have Administrator rights on your machine, or if you are not sure what this means, contact your System Administrator for assistance. You may also need an Internet connection during installation if your computer does not have the software needed by EAOR. This Internet connection is used by the installation process to retrieve software needed by EAOR Reviewer Version 2018-1. It is recommended that you close all other applications during this installation.

**Minimum System Requirements** - This section describes the minimum configuration requirements for a computer where EAOR Reviewer Version 2018-1 is to be installed. If the minimum requirements are not met, EAOR Reviewer Version 2018-1 setup will block the installation of the redistributable package. Specifically, note that you cannot install the .NET Framework on a computer running the Microsoft Windows 95 operating system.

**Required software** - EAOR Reviewer Version 2018-1 uses Microsoft Data Access Component (MDAC) 2.8 SP1 or later and .NET Frameworks 2.0 and 3.5 and **for DEP District Office users, the Oracle Client**. Microsoft provides MDAC and the .NET Framework and Oracle provides the Oracle Client at no charge.

MDAC is a framework of interrelated Microsoft technologies that allows programmers a uniform and comprehensive way of developing applications that can access almost any data store, and is required for **EAOR Reviewer Version 2018-1** to work correctly. Please see Appendix A for installing MDAC.

The Microsoft .NET Framework is a component of the Microsoft Windows® operating system used to build and run Windows-based applications. If the version of this software is not on your computer, the setup process will use your connection to the Internet to install it for you. Please see Appendix B for more information about the .NET Framework updates.

**Operating System Requirements** - To install EAOR Reviewer Version 2018-1, you must have one of the following operating systems with Microsoft Internet Explorer 6 or later installed on your computer.

Microsoft Windows 2003 Server with the latest Windows service pack and critical updates available from the Microsoft Security Web site ([www.microsoft.com/security](http://www.microsoft.com/security)).

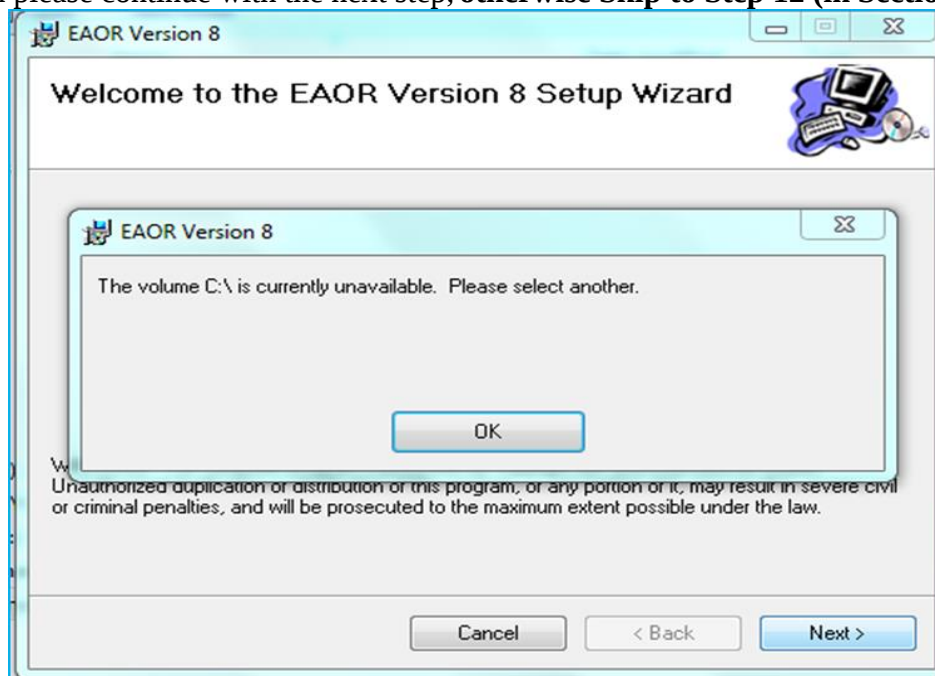


**Note: (If EAOR Reviewer Installation Failed):** - For a few systems, if crystal reports are already installed then EAOR Installer will show the following popup message which says "...Crystal Reports...has failed to install...Fatal error during installation...". You need to **close** that popup and **Uninstall Crystal Reports Basic Runtime for Visual Studio 2008** and then run the **EAOR\_Reviewer\_2018\_1.exe**.
