Hernando	No records prior to June 1998. However, paper permits were issued from 1972 to June, 1998 totaling 35,795 exist in paper form in our office. The Centrax records also exist in paper form since Centrax is not capable of capturing engineering plans and site plans (additional 19,123 permits) Census data indicates there are 82,057 households in Hernando County. 19,123 OSTDS permits are in Centrax (including migrated data) leaving 34,996 pre-centrax OSTDS. Since 35,795 pre-Centrax paper records exist in the office, I assume the remaining 800 permits are commercial systems. This seems like a small number of commercial OSTDS permits, but there is a proportionally smaller number of commercial OSTDS than most counties since we are a predominately suburban community.
Highlands	We have no other paper or electronic records before to 1994 all records from 1994 to the present were migrated to EHD from centrax. All records that were migrated are complete
Hillsborough	No records prior to approximately 1995, spotty from 1995-1999, pretty good from 1999 except where migration of data messed up existing data. in question 7 you use the term successfully. In my opinion very few were migrated successfully. the EHD appears to have made up data using other sources as well as defaulting wrong address info on some records
Holmes	No records before 1996 and only parcel records from 1996 till initiation.
Indian River	No records are in EHD prior to March 30, 1998. As mentioned before, method of some data entry in Centrax caused migrated data in EHD to appear incomplete and inconsistent.

Orange	No records before 1999 The records from 1999-2003 may be missing information since the staff only put in centrax the very basics. For instance, the septic staff here in Orange County would not put a street number on the permit occasionally. They would put lot block and street name but no street number.
Osceola	No records before 1998 and some records between 1998 and 2008 are incomplete. Missing names system just states legacy
Palm Beach	no records before 1999
Pasco	No Records Before 1998.
Pinellas	Many records entered prior to 2005 are incomplete. Many of our OSTDS records were kept using a "plat book" type system prior to 2005, but most of the data was also entered into the CENTRAX system.
Polk	no records before 1998 We have not noticed any issues with CENTRAX migrated system locations, just other issues, with operating permits
Putnam	no records before centrax We have a data base that contains some information on earlier records that was not migrated. The info is very limited, but may be of some help.

Sarasota	There are no permit records at all for pre-1972 due to a fire (so I am told). 1972-2005 was entered into a dos database. 2006 our county started centrax for OSTDS (we were the last in the state). 2006/2007 information was migrated from centrax into rehost and exclusive rehost entry began.
Seminole	No paper or electronic records before 1999. A portion of the data migrated/transferred into REHOST is inaccurate. See above. Addresses, phone numbers, specifications by are inaccurate.
St Lucie	We have 2 Excel spreadsheets: SEPTOLD covers from 1986 to 1989 (6827 entries) and SEPTANK covers from 1990 to 1998 (8228 entries). There were also paper permits going back to 1962 which, due to the lack of standardization and weaker rules, did not have sufficient information to locate and were thus destroyed. In addition, their condition had seriously deteriorate from insects, mice and moisture. We have more documentation than systems still in existance since the City of Port St Lucie completed water and sewer expansion in 2006. Systems were converted at the rate of hundreds per month but we wer not informed. Both our spread sheets and Utilities' customer lists were sent to Envirostep at their request.
St. Johns	Most CENTRAX RECORDS from 1994 forward.
Sumter	records for the old DOH "OSTDS" program which was migrated into CENTRAX are from 1995 - 2000 and are incomplete.
Suwannee	We have no records before 1982. We keep up with records 1982 to 2000 using a card-catalog type system. We are working on a technical problem that has a lot of permits in one individuals name due to an entry error default.
Taylor	Records prior to 2002 are incomplete. We are in the process of scanning all old paper permits and putting on server. Some are not in Rehost.
Union	No records before 1998 records in rehost may not have complete parcel IDs or accurate addresses.
Volusia	No records before 1999.
Wakulla	Those records prior to the requirement of Centrax.
Walton	No records before 1998. Tried to run report out of rehost to pull all applications since 1998, but rehost only pulled from 3/26/2007 to present. Old centrax database (1998 -2007) indicates 7277 systems installed.
