

Indian River Lagoon (IRL) Basin Management Action Plans (BMAPs) GIS Data Request August 14, 2009



The purpose of this handout is to give examples of the types of data that would be useful to create a base or reference map. The Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) will consolidate datasets into geodatabases for each BMAP. This data will then be used to generate large format maps for use in a maps on the table exercise in an upcoming BMAP technical meeting. This is a brainstorming exercise where stakeholders share their knowledge to enhance the groups understanding of existing systems, potential sources, hydrology, etc in the IRL subbasin. All data and maps will be posted to the IRL BMAP FTP site and available for download, with the exception of proprietary data. Proprietary data should meet Florida Public records laws definition of proprietary,

Examples of data that could be provided, if available, include:

- Jurisdictional Boundaries
- Soils
- Flood/FEMA
- Aerials (post 2004);
- Land Use (post 2004)
- Water Quality Stations
- Stormwater Data

 - o Closed Conveyances – Underground Piping
 - o Ponds
 - o Treatment Systems
- Wastewater Data
 - Force and Gravity Mains
 - Sewer Service Areas

 - OSTDS Systems
