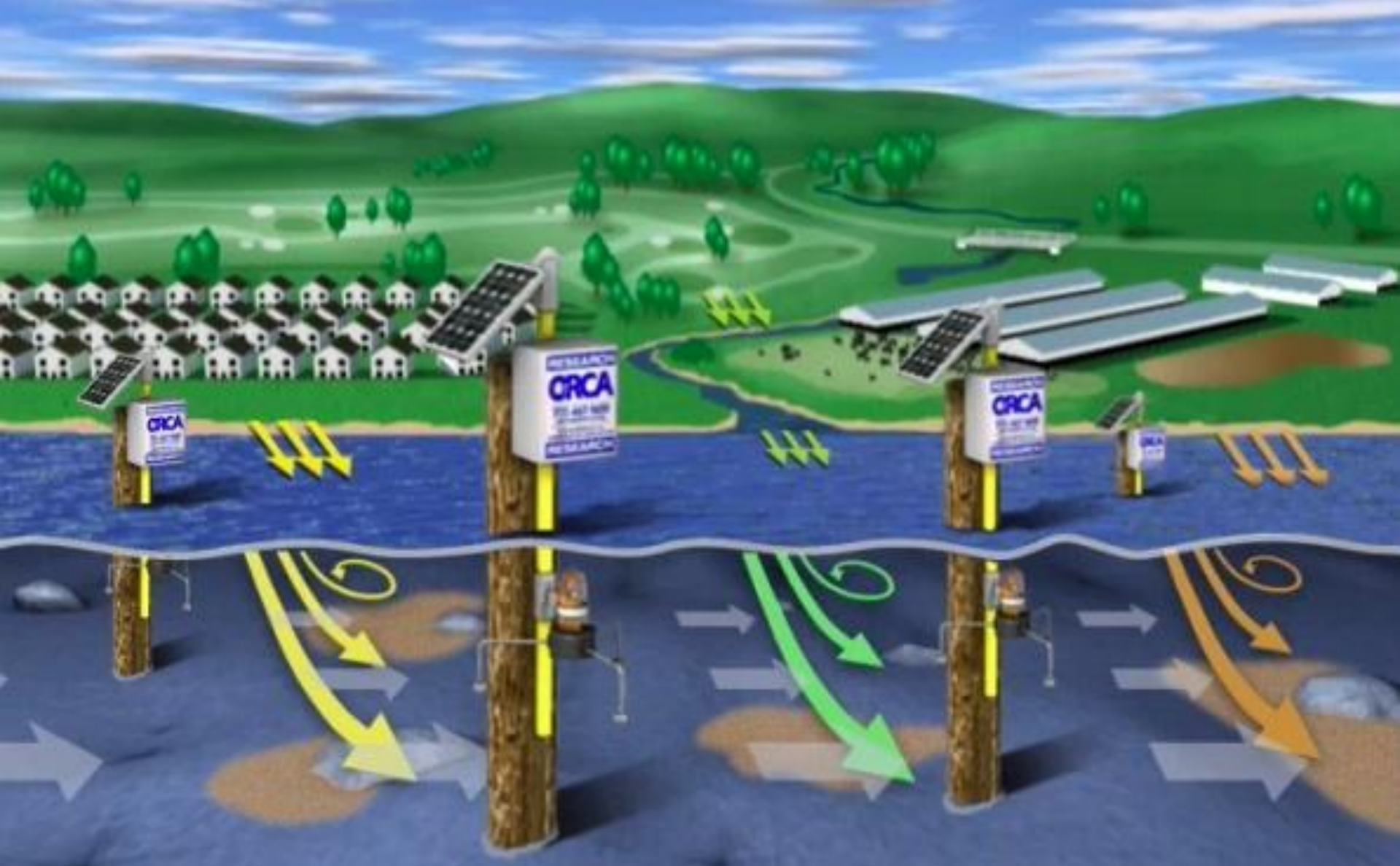

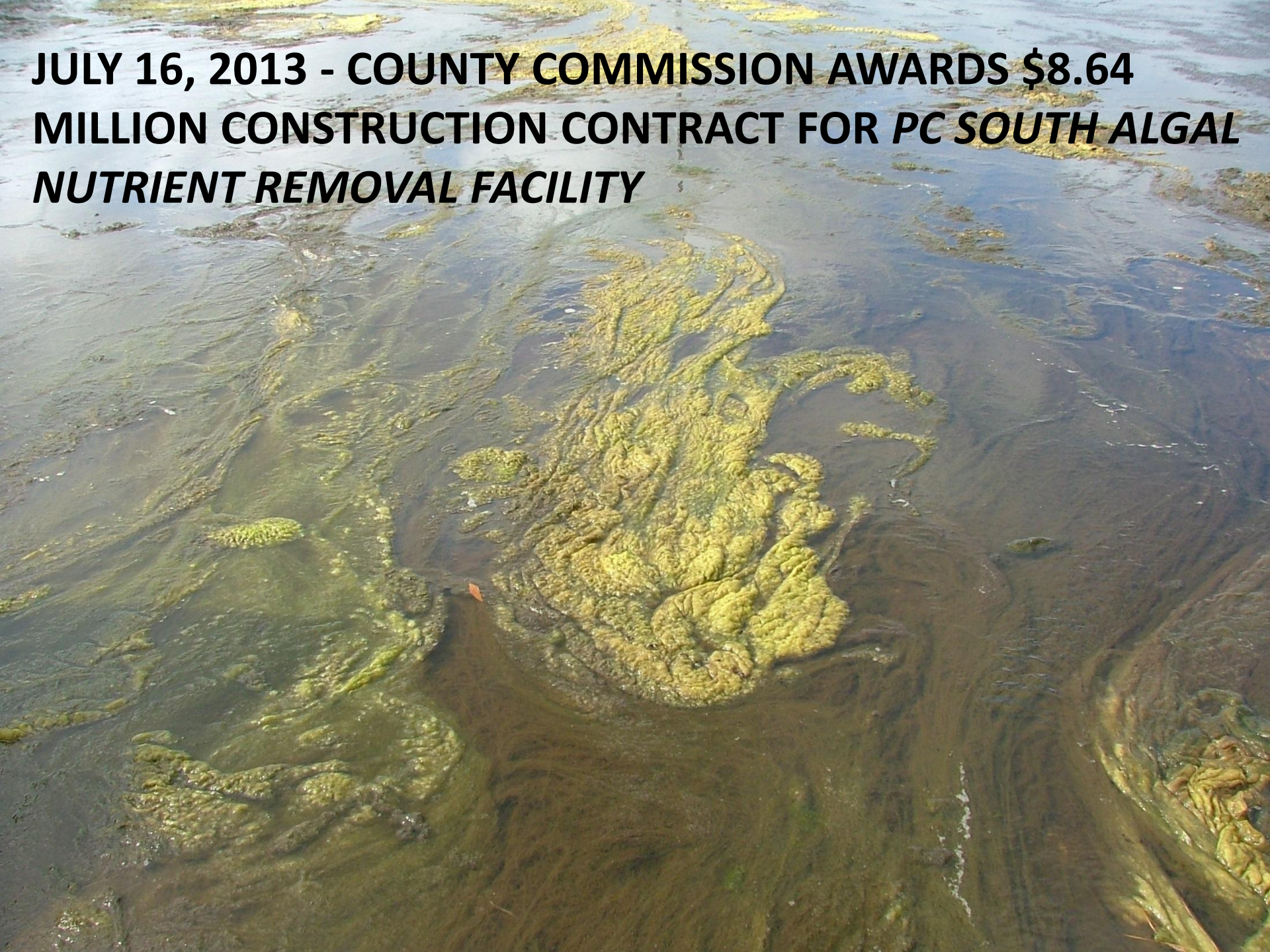

JULY 18, 2013 - COUNTY COMMISSION PASSES FERTILIZER ORDINANCE

- BASED ON *STATE MODEL FERTILIZER ORDINANCE*
- MANDATES AT LEAST 50% SLOW-RELEASE NITROGEN
- MANDATES CONSISTENT 10-FOOT SETBACK FOR APPLYING NEAR WATER BODIES
- PROHIBITS PHOSPHORUS BASED FERTILIZER UNLESS SOIL TESTS INDICATE PHOSPHORUS DEFICIENCY IN SOIL
- EXEMPTS LAWN CARE PROFESSIONALS
- EXEMPTS GOLF COURSES
- DOES NOT LIMIT FERTILIZER APPLICATION DURING THE RAINY SEASON
