STAKEHOLDERS INCLUDED IN THE NORTH IRL BMAP

The Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) for the main stem of the IRL includes allocations to the wastewater treatment facilities (WWTFs) in the basin and these allocations will be included in the BMAP. The TMDL also lists the municipal separate storm sewer systems (MS4s) in the basin and the allocations to the MS4s will be determined through the BMAP process. In addition, there are other urban and agricultural stormwater entities in the basin that will likely receive an allocation.
