**Subject:** Orlando project collection for the Lake Okeechobee BMAP

Lisa,

The Florida Department of Environmental Protection has been working with the stakeholders in the Lake Okeechobee Watershed to prepare the 5-Year Review and update of the adopted Lake Okeechobee Basin Management Action Plan (BMAP). The 5-Year Review is being prepared to meet legislative requirements in Chapter 373.4595 (4), Florida Statutes, which require that a review of the adopted BMAP be completed five years after adoption, which is the end of December 2019. In addition, the BMAP is being updated to meet the requirement of Executive Order 19-12 that the restoration plans impacting South Florida communities are updated by January 2020.

As part of the 5-Year Review and BMAP Update, we are gathering information about planned and future projects in the Lake Okeechobee BMAP watershed. The BMAP watershed now includes all nine sub-watersheds, north and south of the lake. Attached is your current project list. Please provide any edits or updates to the project status through June 30, 2019. In addition, attached is a project collection sheet for information on future projects. These projects are not commitments, but instead meant to help us determine future BMAP milestones and what projects may occur further out in the BMAP timeline. You do not need to complete all the columns for the project information – at a minimum, please provide a name and description, as well as funding needs in the "Funding Status" column. For any estimated nutrient reduction benefits, please provide supporting details.

We are also working to refine the BMAP monitoring network. Please find attached the list of your stations currently included in the BMAP. These stations are listed for the Lake Toho NRP and the data will be tracked through the BMAP. Please provide any updates to the station information and any additional stations that should be included. The data for the stations included in the BMAP/NRP monitoring network will be required to be uploaded into WIN at least annually.
