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Remember, Only Rain Down the Drain! Don't let pollution happen.

It is each homeowner's and lawn maintenance personnel's responsibility to prevent leaves, grass clippings, and other yard debris from entering the streets and stormwater system. No matter where you live in Orlando, your property drains to a nearby lake, either over land or through underground pipes.

- Yard Waste clogs storm drains, leading to flooding.
- Yard waste enters lakes through stormwater system. Decomposing yard waste contains nitrogen and phosphorus, which cause lake pollution and consume oxygen needed by fish and other aquatic wildlife.
