that any time someone pours or
sweeps anything into any Orlando
street, parking lot, or alley, it will likely
end up in one of the City's lakes?

The City of Orlando's Streets and Stormwater Division will be actively enforcing codes dealing with pollutant discharges to storm systems. Per City Code, it is prohibited to discharge any pollutants into the lakes or any part of the stormwater system, which includes streets, parking lots, alleys, sidewalks, storm drains, and retention/detention ponds. Code Enforcement action may include **finest up to \$1,000 per day** of violation and reimbursement for expenses incurred by the City in carrying out pollution abatement.

Many Orlando businesses discard debris or discharge wastewater onto the ground and into the storm drains, contributing to lake pollution.

AVOID FINES UP TO \$1000 PER DAY! Your business must follow best management practices to ensure you are not contributing to stormwater pollution.

1. NEVER dump wash water or mop water into paved areas, storm drains or waterbodies.
2. NEVER hose down floormats, filters, garbage cans or dirty dishes in paved areas or near storm drains; this should all be done indoors.
3. NEVER pour grease or oil into sinks, floor drains, paved areas, storm drains or waterbodies.
4. Clean up spills immediately by using DRY cleanup methods. Do not hose down spills.
