

RESTAURANT, BAR AND FOOD SERVICE

Your business must follow best management practices to ensure you are not contributing to stormwater pollution:

1. **Pour all mop water and other wastewater into utility or wash sink.** NEVER dump wash water into paved areas, storm drains, or waterbodies.
2. **Make sure that waste disposal drains are not connected to stormwater systems.**
3. **Have grease traps regularly serviced to prevent clogs** and do not wait until overflow occurs.
4. **Add a grease and oil recycling storage area on site; keep it cleaned and covered.** Always recycle and never pour grease or oil into sinks, floor drains, paved areas, storm drains, or waterbodies.
5. **Clean all pots and pans in utility sink or dishwasher.** Never hose down greasy pans into paved areas, storm drains, or waterbodies.
6. **Sweep and collect floor waste into a leak-proof container.** Deposit wastes in trash receptacle only. Never hose into paved areas, storm drains, or waterbodies.
7. **Use dry cleanup methods only for spills.** Keep absorbent materials (e.g. Oil Dri, kitty litter, etc) on hand to assist in containing spills. Never hose down a food or chemical spill.
8. **Clean floormats, filters and garbage cans in a utility sink or large grassy area.** Never hose them down in paved areas or near storm drains.
9. **Do not allow water from exhaust hood cleaning operation to enter stormwater system.**
10. **Keep dumpster area clean and covered. Ensure dumpster plug is in place.** Never fill dumpster with liquid waste or hose into paved areas and storm drains.
11. **Confirm that all sub-contractors are licensed and follow proper industry procedures to prevent stormwater pollution.**
