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PICK UP AFTER YOUR POOCH!

It's the Law: Orlando City code requires you to pick up after your pet. It's a nuisance, and leads to water pollution no matter where you live. Violation of Orange County Ordinance Sec. 5-50 includes a fine for un-scooped pet waste.



GET THE SCOOP on UN-SCOOPED POOP

- Washes into storm drains, which drain to local lakes, harming human health and the environment.
- Reduces the amount of dissolved oxygen in the water – resulting in fish kills.
- Adds excess nutrients to lakes – resulting in algae blooms (a stagnant blanket of green).
- **It's BEST...** Pick up after your pet. Dispose of waste in the toilet or trash.



DOG WASHING TIPS

- Even biodegradable products can cause water pollution. Follow product instructions and clean up spills.
- **It's GOOD...** Outside, wash pets on the lawn instead of the pavement. Keep washwater from running into storm drains.
- **It's BEST...** Bathe your pets indoors or visit a professional groomer.



FLEA CONTROL

- **It's GOOD...** Dispose of any unused products like shampoos, sprays or collars at a Household Hazardous Waste Collection Center. Call 407.836.660.
- **It's BEST...** Consider using oral or topical flea control products.
