Q: Kelly Young asked if House Bill (HB) 1379 will require all septic systems to be upgraded if they're within the BMAP boundary?

A: Lauren Campbell responded that HB 1379 applies to new septic systems. There are no prohibitions for existing systems in all BMAPs. She added that the existing system requirements in HB 1379 are for Indian River Lagoon, where existing systems will require enhanced treatment. For Harney Monroe, the bill only says that no new conventional septic systems will be permitted in the BMAP boundary.
