- 72% of all agricultural acres are enrolled in the FDACS BMP program
- 78% of all irrigated agricultural acres are enrolled in the FDACS BMP program
- Majority of enrollments are in Cow/Calf

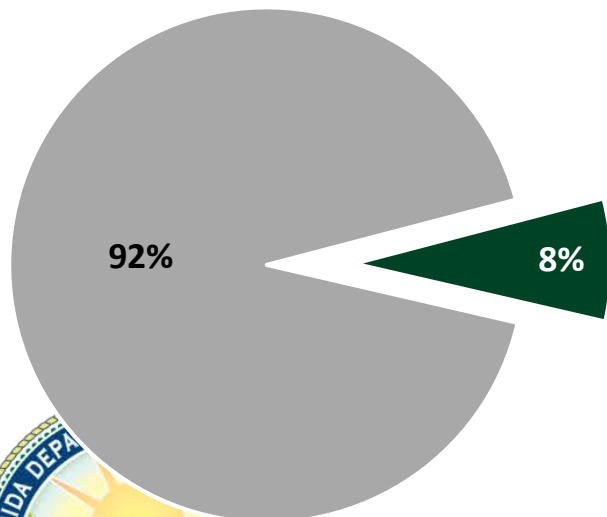

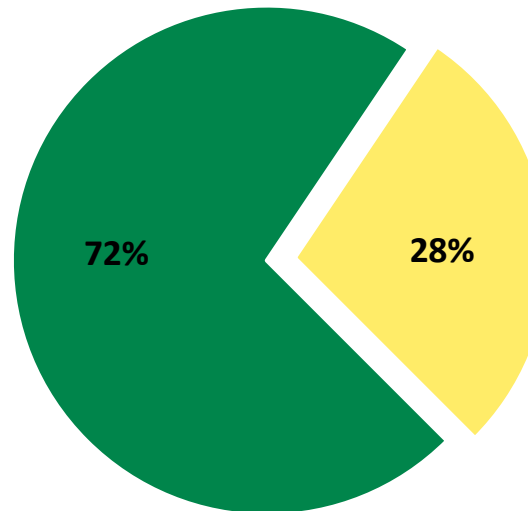

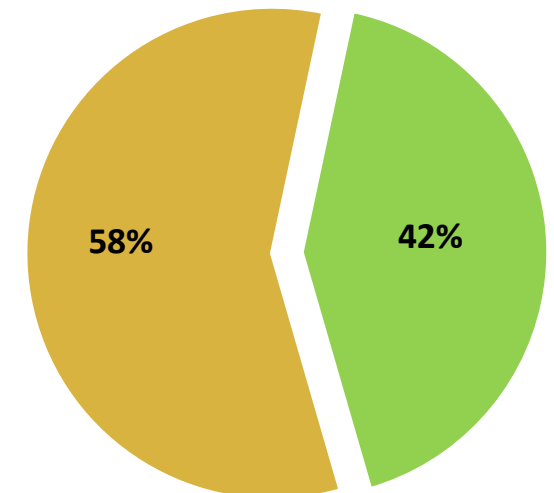
**BMAP Area vs

Remaining Acreage**



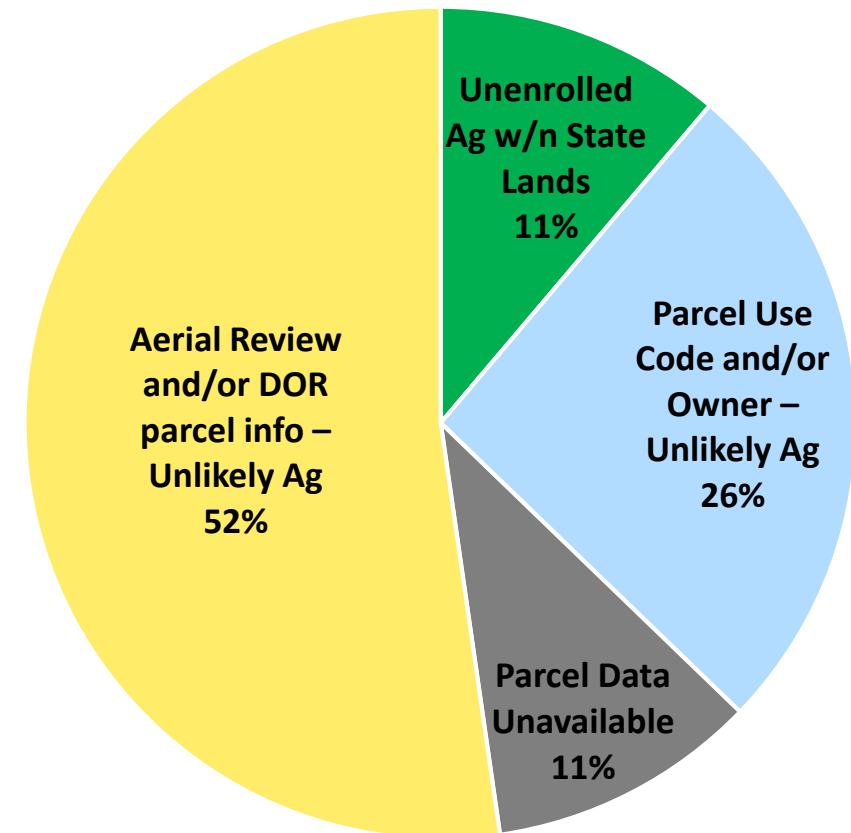

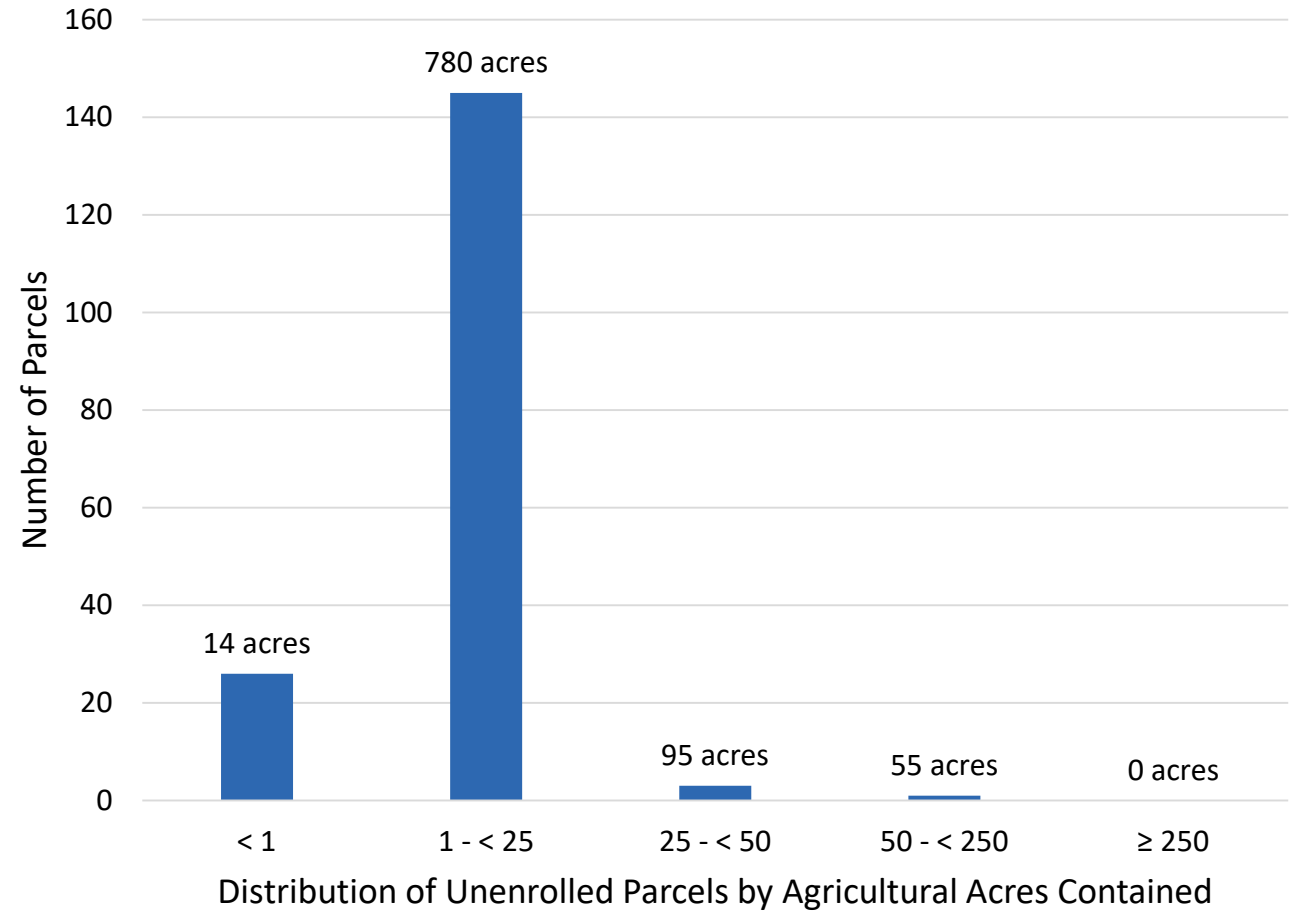

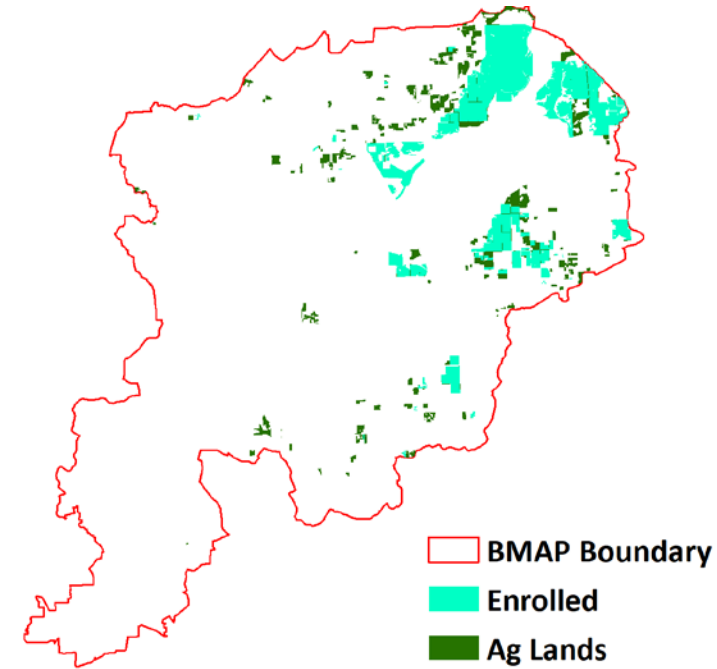

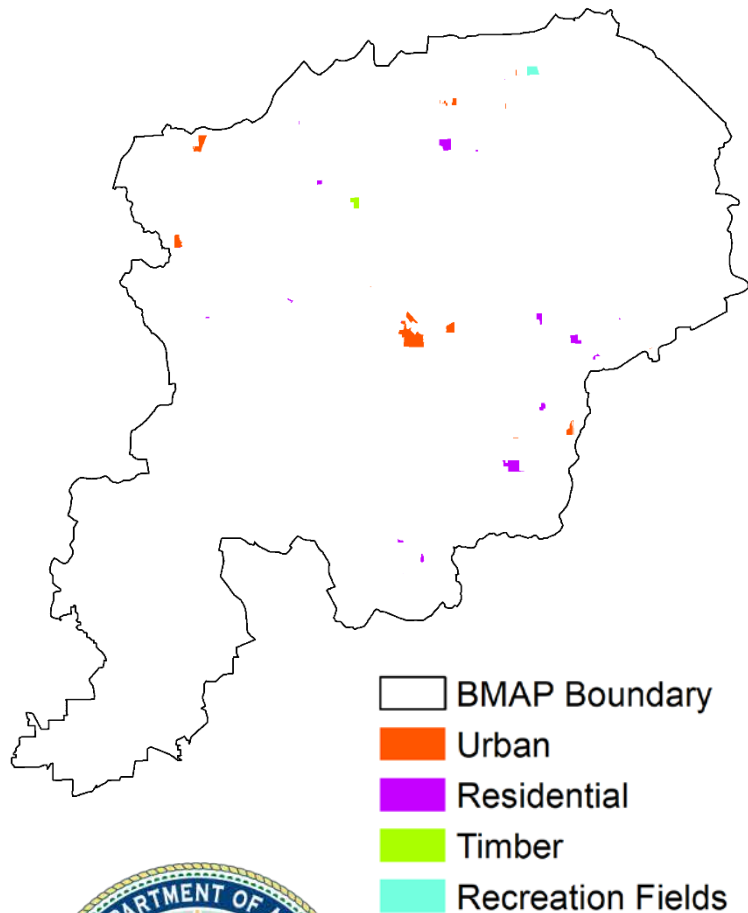

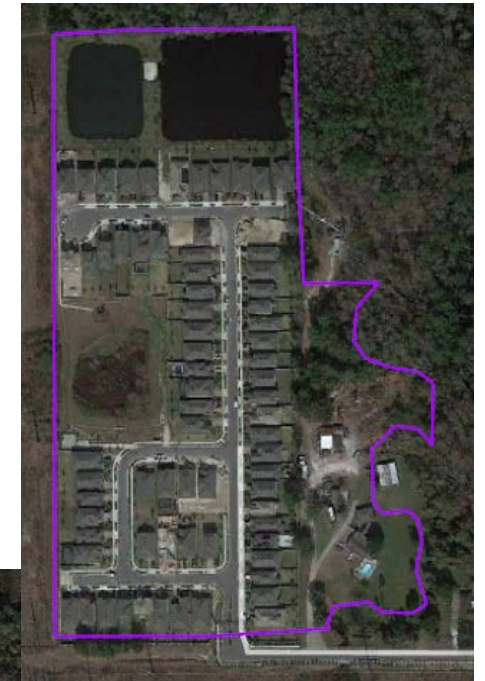
