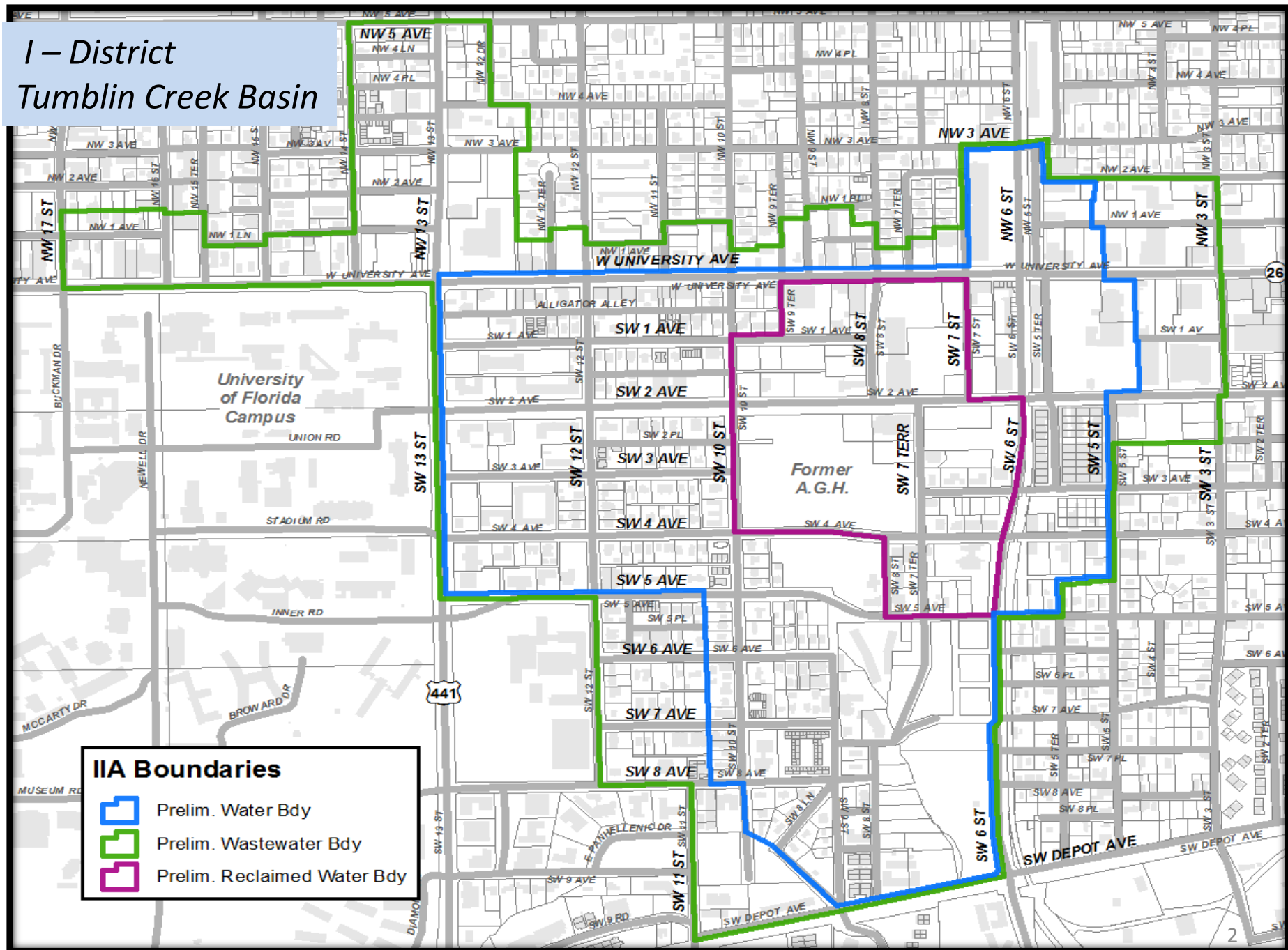

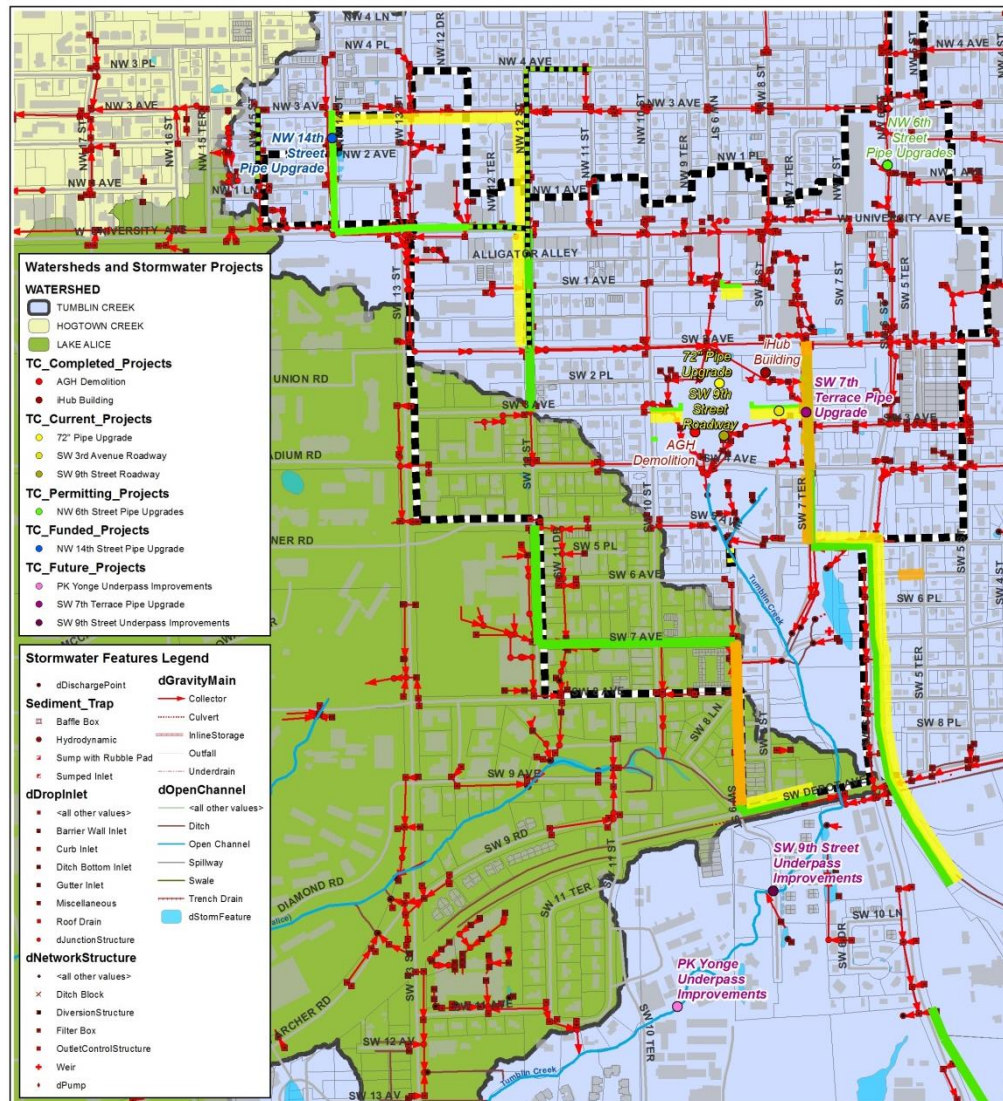

GRU will pay 40% of the cost for additional wastewater infrastructure improvements within the designated Urban Core area.

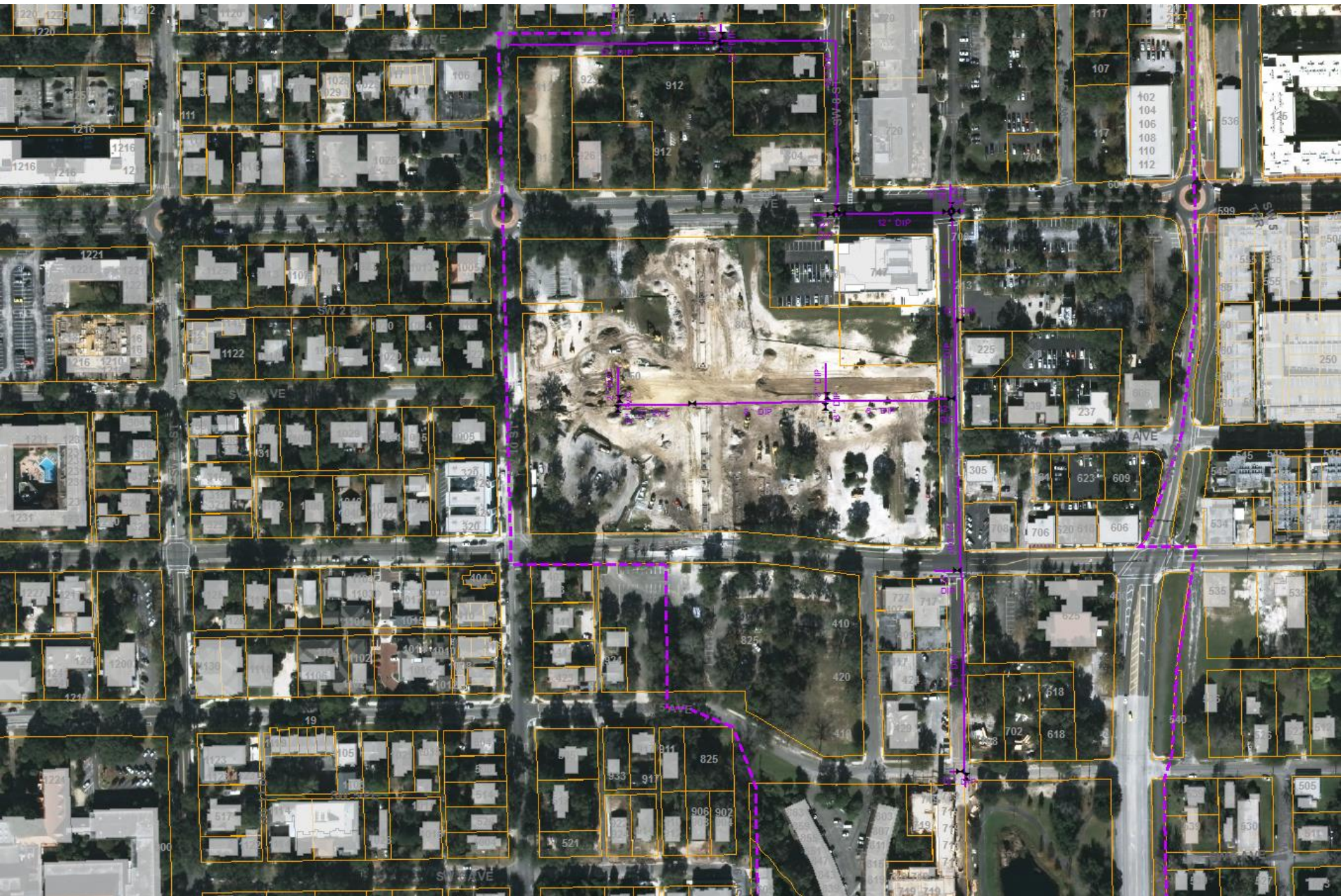

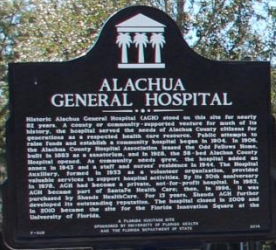

ALACHUA GENERAL HOSPITAL

History: Alachua General Hospital (AGH) opened its doors on June 1, 1888, as a small, one-story building on the corner of 1st Street and Central Avenue. It was the first hospital in the area and served as a place of refuge for the community. The hospital was known for its excellent medical care and its commitment to the community. In 1918, the hospital was expanded to include a new wing. In 1943, the hospital was renamed Alachua General Hospital. 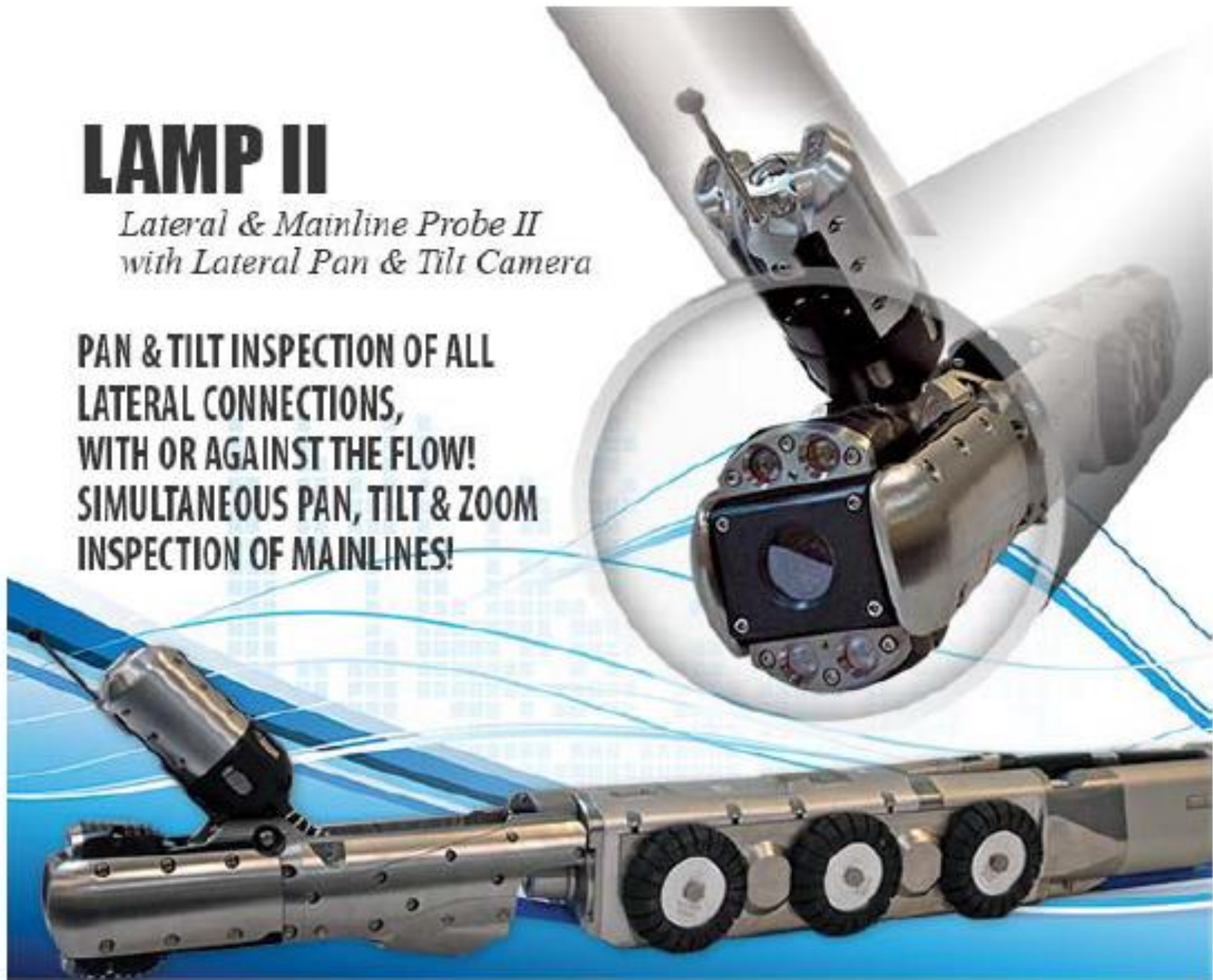
