Water Quality Improvement Projects

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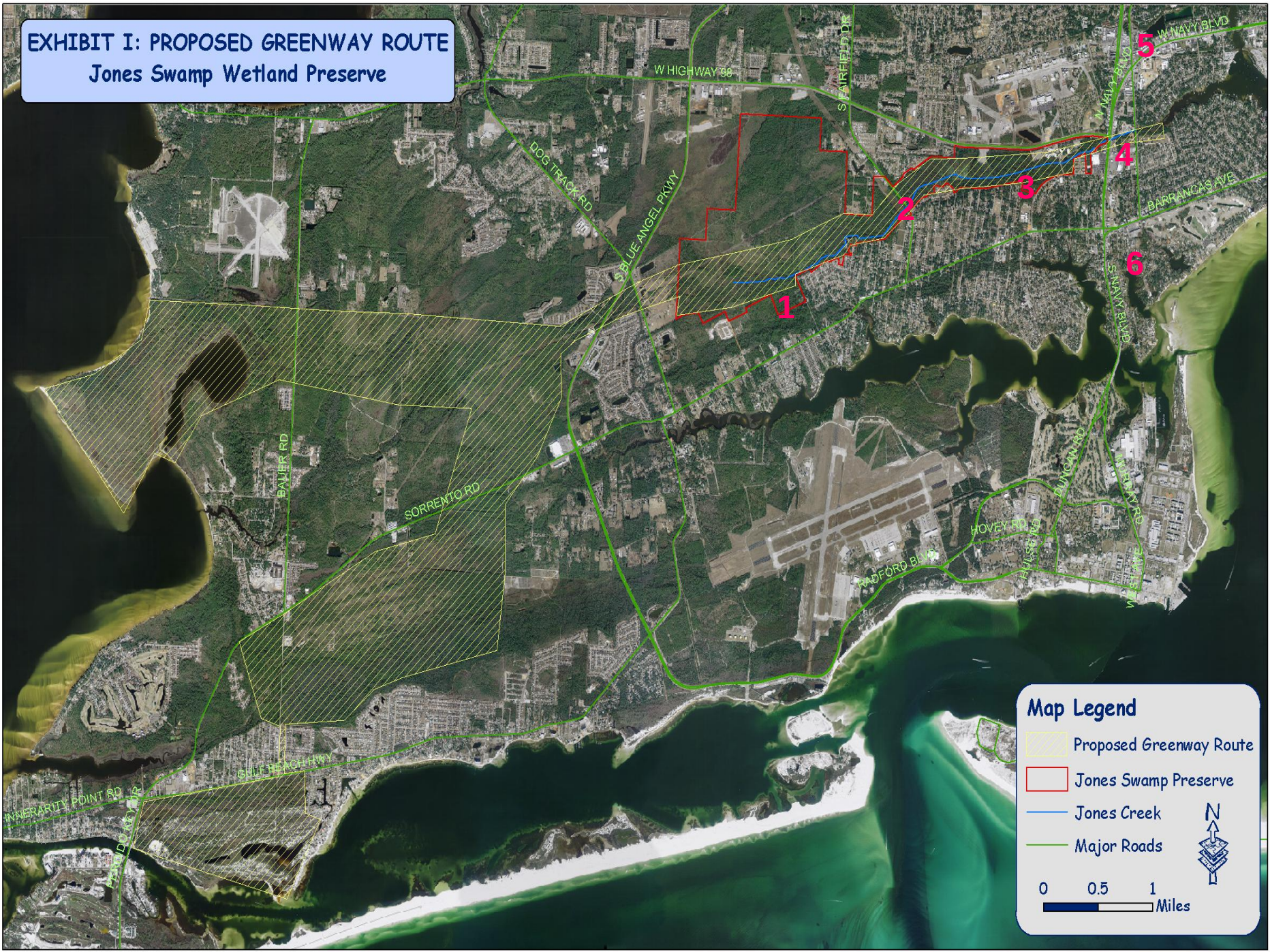
Impacts to Surface Water Quality

- Impervious surfaces – stormwater runoff from parking lots, roads, driveways, roofs (>20% causes impairment)
- Industrial discharges – past and present
- Wastewater treatment plant discharges
- Agricultural runoff – animal wastes, fertilizers, pesticides, eroded sediment
- Contaminated groundwater – septic tanks, industry
- Yards – fertilizer, pesticides, animal wastes
- Recreational activities – golf, boating, hunting
- Atmospheric deposition – nitrogen, mercury

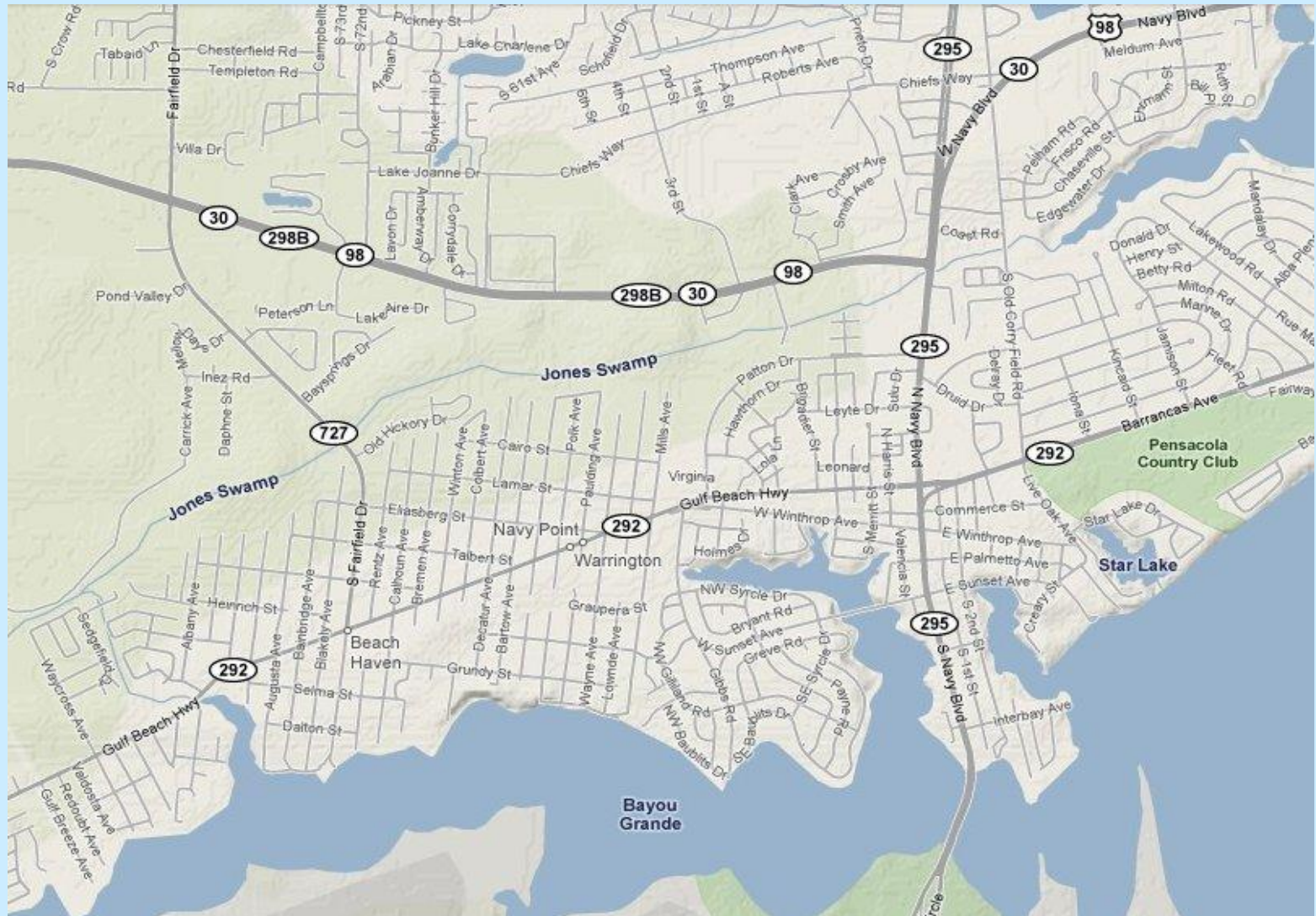

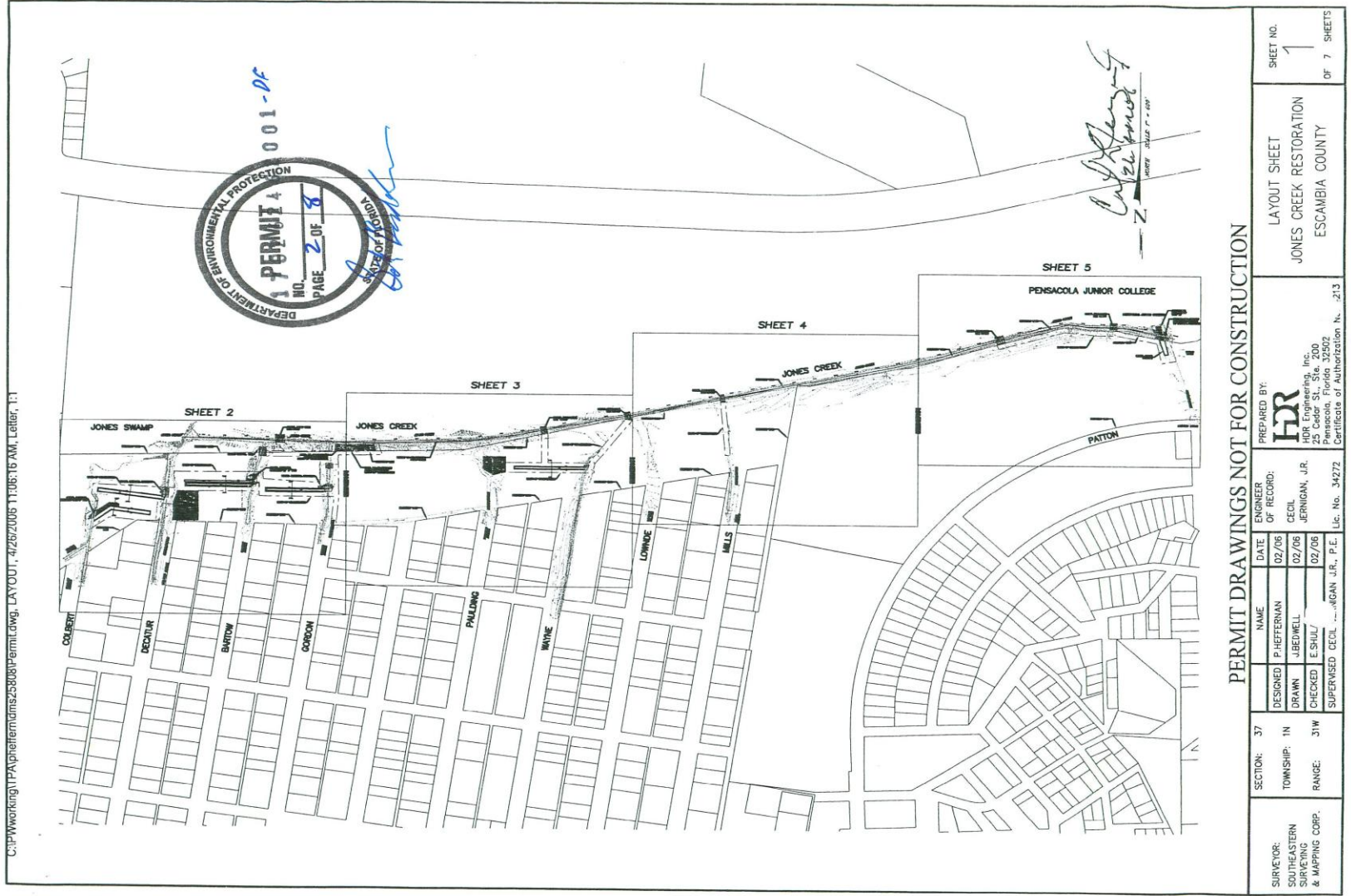

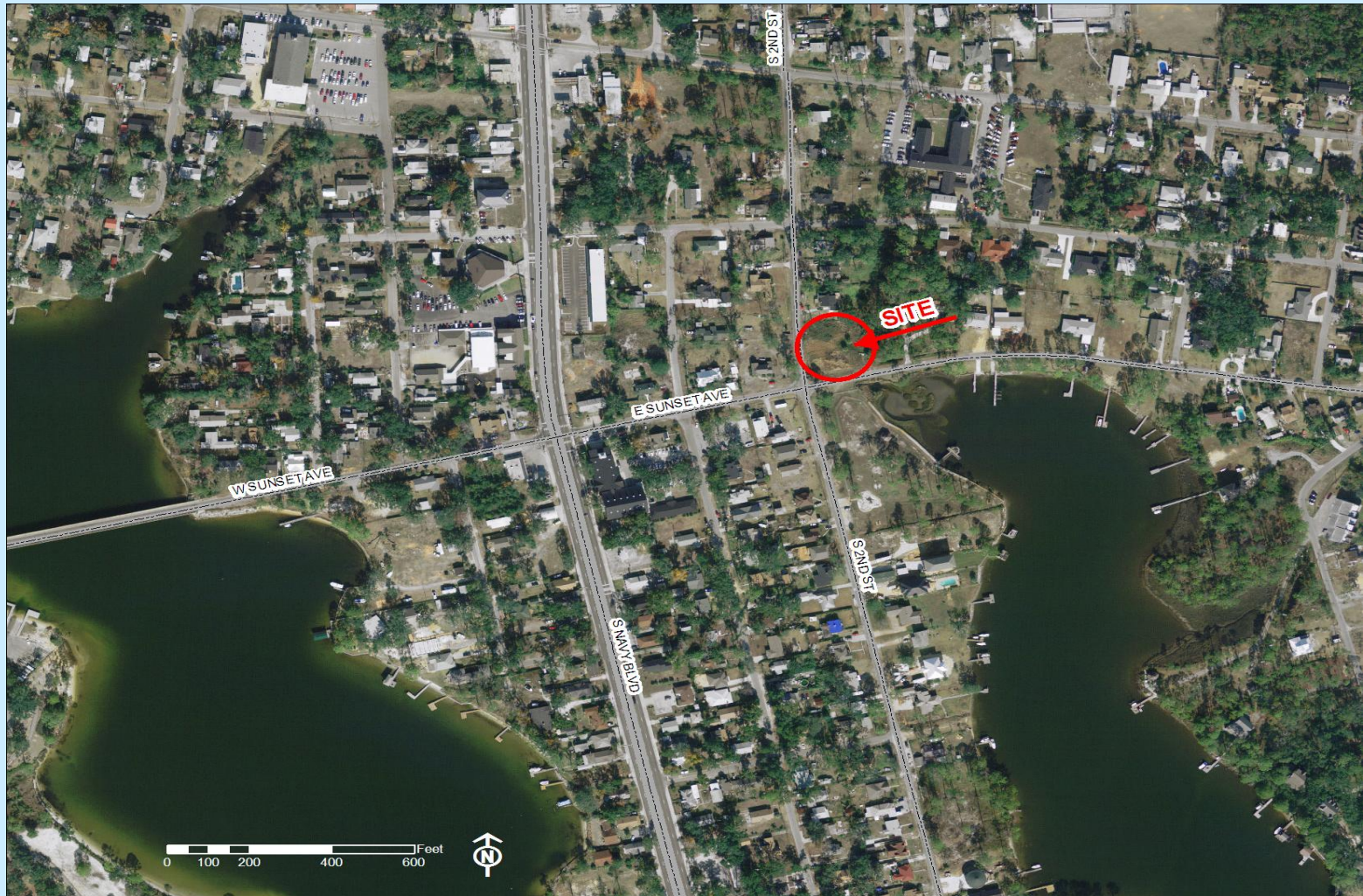
