

Wakulla Springs State Park
Submerged Aquatic Vegetation Survey Project

This is an on-going project to collect quarterly data on submerged aquatic vegetation (SAV) coverage and dominant species composition along seven transects in the Upper Wakulla River. A collaborative effort by park staff and volunteers from the Friends of Wakulla Springs and the Wakulla Springs Alliance, data have been collected quarterly since April 2013.

Cover types for which percent cover is estimated include:

- bare bottom
- total SAV cover
 - o algae
 - o Hydrilla
 - o Naiad
 - o Illinois pond weed
 - o Sagittaria kurziana
 - o Vallisneria americana
