- For WP-52 I would need to know what type of upgrade was made to determine how to calculate credit or if it qualifies for credit.
- For WP-54, alum injection, we need a shapefile of the treated area.

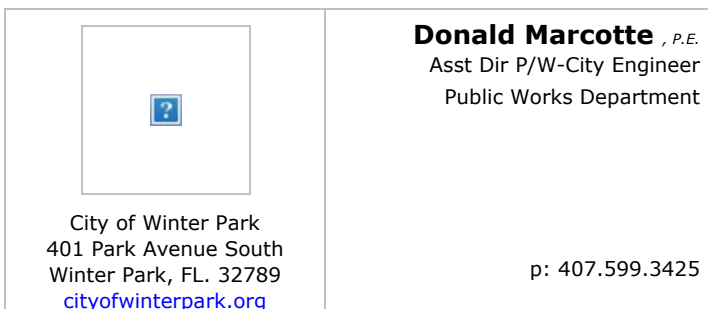

This annual report of progress towards implementing water quality and quantity projects will greatly assist policymakers and local stakeholders in keeping track of the myriad of restoration strategies, fulfilling the requirements of Section 403.0675, Florida Statutes (F.S.). As part of the STAR, we will include updates on the status of all basin management action plan (BMAP) projects through December 31, 2019.

  - b. Annual Project Update Instructions

- Supporting documents (attached) have been provided to assist with completing the project tables and verifying new/updated project credits. Adherence to these guidelines is important for consistency in this statewide report, and for meeting the statutory submission deadline.
