Because of this I do not think that changing the attenuation rates for the RIB is possible since the BMAP has already gone through development and this rate was used in modeling the loads. During the 5-year revision would be a good time to ask for modifications that could change the modeled loading.

Good Morning Tina,

Thank you for providing us the updated GIS layer to assist with our calculations. Please see the attached spreadsheet that provides the City of Orlando's daily volume of flow into the Water Conserv II Distribution Center. The volume we provided is considerably larger than what was recently calculated for TN/TP reductions in Project ORL-28.

The City also possesses data that suggests the RIB attenuation percentage is greater than 25%. We will reach out to you once we obtain more accurate information. Please let us know if you have any questions. We are looking forward to seeing the updated reductions that will reflect the new flow volumes.
