Afternoon Tom...

Per the requirements of statute, the Office of Agricultural Water Policy (OAWP) is transmitting several files regarding producers/property owners that have not enrolled in the OAWP best management practices (BMP) program. Given their lack of enrollment and implementation of those BMPs that have been previously been verified to be effective by your office, the presumption of compliance with state water quality standards provided for in Section 403.067, F.S. is not applicable and we leave it to your office to initiate those proceedings necessary under the statutory authority granted to your agency, including monitoring to ensure compliance with state water quality standards. Please find attached our letter of transmittal. Kim will be transmitting a link to the ftp site on which you will find the files. Our apologies as they were well over the limits for transmittal via email. Please note that the letter additionally requests that we finalize in a memorandum of agreement the process through which we provide files to your office. This will allow us to undertake this process with greater efficiency and effectiveness as we continue to closely collaborate to implement our statutory obligations.
