Per the requirements of statute, the Office of Agricultural Water Policy (OAWP) is transmitting several files regarding producers/property owners that have not enrolled in the OAWP best management practices (BMP) program in the St. Lucie watershed. Given their lack of enrollment and implementation of BMPs, the presumption of compliance with state water quality standards provided for in section 403.067, F.S., is not applicable to these producer and leave it to your office to initiate those proceedings necessary under the statutory authority granted to your agency, including monitoring to ensure compliance with state water quality standards.
