Subject: Triennial Review of Florida's Water Quality Standards

Dear Official, Please adopt the 2016 EPA draft recommended water quality criteria of 4 micrograms per liter for microcystin and 8 micrograms per liter for cylindrospermopsin to best protect recreational users and restore Florida's imperiled waters.

The beaches have "flags" or "postings" which are sometimes helpful, but many times not because they are not current. I would like to see a website with accurate up to date info on what is happening BEFORE driving to the beach, and being exposed to the air borne toxin, never mind the water.

I would also like to see a ban of the widespread spraying of our waters, and ban on using any type of fertilizer on any land in the state of Florida, to allow our waters to recover from the onslaught of pollutants.
