Earlier this year, at my urging, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency stated that anything about 8 parts per billion of microcystin (which results from toxic algal blooms) is unsafe for human contact. In 2018, measured levels in our community reached as high as 495 parts per billion - **more than 60 times what is safe for human contact!**
