Hello:

For too long Florida Agriculture (including the spreading of biosolids) has gone unchecked in regards to overloading nutrient into our watersheds and creating toxic algae blooms that are hazardous to our health. I am writing to urge you and the department to not only increase testing frequency for toxicity but further enforce limits on nutrient loading of Florida's watersheds.

In 2018 our backyard became toxic and unusable due to a massive algal bloom that not only had a gagging smell, but was clearly unsafe. I would not allow my family into our backyard and the summer was lost for my son who likes to fish from our dock. I have included a photo of our plight from 2018 in Cape Coral FL.
