- FREE 3-DAY Training Program to obtain state qualification from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection's Stormwater, Erosion, & Sedimentation Control Inspector Qualification Certificate Program and includes the hands-ons demonstrations and case studies of current erosion and turbidity technologies.

This qualification does not expire or require CEUs unlike other states.
