- A real interest in training others in erosion and sediment control, and the ability to teach or assist with at least one class a year to maintain an active instructor's status
- Minimum of one year experience working in erosion and sedimentation control and inspection
- Minimum of 80% grade on the FSESCI Inspector Exam

This workshop is offered throughout the year by the FSESCI Training Program Statewide Training Coordinator to prepare new instructors for the training program. The workshop covers the guidelines instructors are required to follow in order to teach the class. It also allows instructors an opportunity to work on both their teaching skills and speaking abilities. Upon the completion of the workshop, a certificate and instructor number are provided by DEP to show that an instructor is DEP-approved.

The program has been training Floridians for over twenty years through five different manuals. Instructors are from both the private and public sectors, and they all share a common interest in the education of others in erosion and sediment control. Through this training, Floridians learn how to better control runoff from construction sites and disturbed areas to help protect our vital surface waters throughout the state of Florida.
