The Florida Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Waste Management (Division) has reviewed the information provided on the Levuk Method. Per NFA Solutions Group Incorporated description, the Levuk Method is a closed-loop re-injection-type system that combines groundwater recovery, soil washing, air sparging, and bioremediation.

The Levuk Method was originally reviewed by the Division on December 16, 2003, under Innovative Technology Application Number 1294. The method has not changed since that time, but the name and address of the firm have changed. The name of the firm now is NFA Solutions Group Incorporated.

The Department has no objections to using the Levuk Method for site remediation, as long as the detailed site-specific design and evaluation of its applicability and cost-effectiveness are provided and approved in the site specific Remedial Action Plan.
