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Environmental Assessment & Restoration
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The Town of Reddick does not believe it has a demonstrated need to create an OSTDS remediation plan to improve water quality in order to achieve the water quality objectives of the BMAP.

The Town of Reddick is a very small municipality at the edge of the Silver River Management area. It has approx. 205 residences that use wells and septic tanks as their water source and waste water management. There is no industry in the one-square mile the town encompasses, with the only businesses being a drugstore, a general store, a small restaurant and a farm supply business.

Due to the new Form 6 Financial Disclosure law, Reddick now finds itself without a mayor or town council, leaving only a part-time Town Clerk to manage affairs for the present time. Consequently, we have no plans for a waste water treatment facility in the immediate future. Educating residents on water conservation and water run-off can be done through our website and by letter mailout.
