Sample Notes: The sample contained a large algal mat in pink water. The benthic attached diatoms, *Coscinodiscus* sp., *Synedra* sp., and *Entomoneis* sp., were present. Algae appeared alive and healthy.

Result: Dominant taxon was *Lyngbya*-like filamentous cyanobacteria (cf. *Lyngbya majuscula*).
