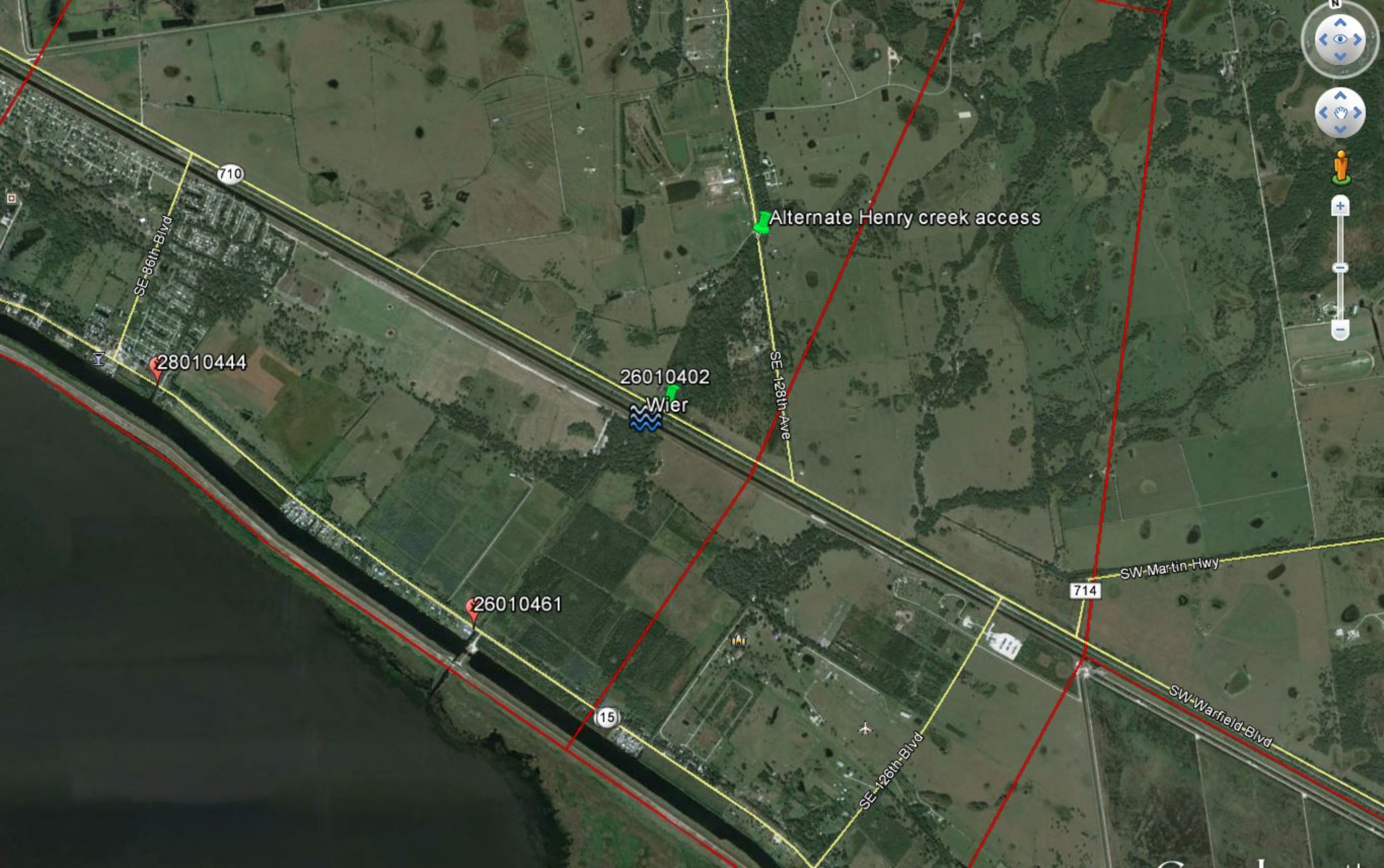

Access to the waterbody of interest is only possible at 2 road crossings within the WBID. The alternate site off of 128<sup>th</sup> is behind a fence and the waterbody has poorly defined banks more like a wetland than an actual stream. Downstream at County Road 710 there is more water and usually has sufficient depth for sampling. ~20m downstream of the road crossing is a wier that separates Henry Creek from L63-S (the current receiving body of water for Henry Creek) under normal water levels. Elevated water levels in L63 allows the water to flow the wrong direction at this site, this has been observed several times by SFWMD and FDEP.

G4SE0002 (new naming convention) was made to replace 26010402. Starting 1/1/2016 the new station will be used for this site.

Station 28010444 is not in the waterbody of interest, and is improperly named in STORET. This station should not be used to represent this WBID. The station is in an offshoot canal of L-47 canal.

Station 26010461 does NOT connect with the waterbody of interest currently.
