Bottle Group B was 1 sample. It looks like you sent in 4.

1 sample of Aherbs, Glyph, Suc, Uherb takes 1 bottle
1 sample of chlorinated pests takes another 4 bottles (2 bottles for sample, 2 for the QC sample)
1 sample of nit/phos pests takes another 4 bottles (2 bottles for sample, 2 for the QC sample)
1 sample of PYR takes 1 more bottle

Total 10 bottles for 1 sample of all these tests.

You did get 1 sample for all these tests (the 9:20 sample) but without the required number of bottles. If they have a QC failure, there is no extra sample to re-run and no QC sample for the matrix spike duplicate.

I added Group D for the other 3 samples; 10:00, 10:30, and 11:00. Including the pesticide tests, PSNP-TQ, PCL-SQ-R, and CT-CI-R. All of those also without sufficient number of bottles and sample volume.

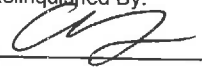
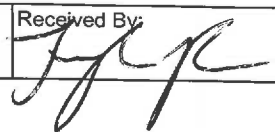

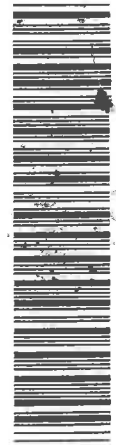
