Jhamieka and Jeremy,

I'm not sure why the one sample submittal was excluded from the chain, it must've been a mistake on the samplers part.

The best I can tell from the sample sheets is that the missing sample on the COC is actually G1NE0917 (PAR262, Pareners Branch) and the bottles were mislabeled for G1NE0906. The samples delivered as G1NE0917 should be G1NE0906

(PAR1491, Pareners Branch – E of CR 1491). The field sheets show that G1NE0906 (PAR1491) was sampeled at 1230, and that G1NE0917 (PAR262) was sampeled at 1345. I also checked and it looks like the field parameters labeled for G1NE0917 on the COC are actually the field parameters for G1NE0906. The field parameters for G1NE0917 should be as follows:
