The times can't be changed; if we changed the overflow micro sample times to match their paperwork, it would change the collection times for all the other samples submitted for those sites (see screenshots below of submittal forms). They're linked in LIMS

The only way to change them would be for you to re-log them in (creating a new sample ID) and cancelling the old samples; probably not worth it to adjust collections a by few minutes.

BTW. Samplers are supposed to put down one collection time per site. Not a different time for each container. Things like this really grinds my gears.
