Sample Type is used to indicate whether the sample was a grab (G) or whether it was a composite (C).

Sample Matrix is used to indicate whether the sample is being analyzed for drinking water (DW), groundwater (GW), surface water (SW), fresh surface water (FSW), salt surface water (SSW), soil sediment (SDMT), or sludge (SLDG).

Container Type is used to indicate whether the container is plastic (P) or glass (G). Sample must be refrigerated or stored in wet ice after collection. The maximum temperature during storage should be 4°C (42.8°F). Under "Preservative," list any preservatives that were added to the sample container.
