1. Each bottle has a label identifying sample ID, preservative, vessel type, container type, client ID, and number for analysis.

2. The following information should be added to each bottle label after collection with appropriate blank ink: date and time of collection, sampler's name or initials, and any field number or ID.

3. All bottles not containing preservative may be mixed with appropriate sample prior to collection.

4. The client is responsible for documentation of the sampling event. Please note: spectral sampling events on this sample comply from.
