1. "Sample Type" is used to indicate whether the sample was a grab (G) or whether it was a composite (C).
 2. "Sample Matrix" is used to indicate whether the sample is being discharged to drinking water (DW), groundwater (GW), surface water (SW), fresh surface water (FSW), saline surface water (SSW), soil, sediment (SDMT), or sludge (SLDG).
 3. "Container Type" is used to indicate whether the container is plastic (P) or glass (G).
 4. Samples must be refrigerated or stored in wet ice after collection. The maximum temperature during storage should be 6°C (42.8°F). Under "Preservative," list any preservatives that were added to the sample container.
 5. Each bottle has a label identifying sample ID, premeasured preservative contained in the bottle, sample type, client ID, and parameters for analysis.
 6. The following information should be added to each bottle label after collection in this permanent black ink: date and time of collection, sampler's name or initials, and any field number or ID.
 7. All bottles and containing preservative may be reused with appropriate sample prior to collection.
 8. The client is responsible for documentation of the sampling event. Please note: special sampling events on this sample custody form.
