1. "Sample Type" is used to indicate whether the sample was a grab (G) or a composite (C).
2. "Sample Matrix" is used to indicate whether the sample is being discharged to drinking water (DW), groundwater (GW), surface water (SW), fresh surface water (FSW), saline surface water (SSW), soil, sediment (SDMNT), or sludge (SLDG).
3. "Container Type" is used to indicate whether the container is plastic (P) or glass (G). Sample must be refrigerated or stored in wet ice after collection. The minimum temperature during storage should be 4°C (40°F). Under "Preservative," list any preservatives that were added to the sample container.
4. Each bottle has a label identifying sample ID, preservative, container, and date. The sample type, client ID, and preservative for analysis.
5. The following information should be added to each bottle after collection and prior to collection.
6. All bottles containing preservative may be mixed with appropriate sample prior to collection.
7. The client is responsible for documentation of the sampling event. Please note special sampling events on the sample custody form.
