Sample Type is used to indicate whether the sample was a grab (G) or whether it was a composite (C).

Sample Matrix* is used to indicate whether the sample is being discharged to drinking water (DW), groundwater (GW), surface water (SW), fresh surface water (FSW), salt surface water (SSW), soil sediment (SDSMT), or sludge (SLDG).

Container Type is used to indicate whether the container is plastic (P) or glass (G).

Sample must be refrigerated or stored in ice after collection. The maximum temperature during storage should be 6°C (41°F). Under "Preservative" list any preservatives that were added to the sample container.

1. Each bottle has a label identifying sample ID, preservative contained in the bottle, sample type, client ID, and parameters for analysis.

2. The following information should be added to each bottle label after collection with pen or black ink: date and time of collection, sample's name or initials, and any field number or ID.

3. All bottles not containing preservative may be fixed with appropriate sample prior to collection.

4. The client is responsible for documentation of the sampling event. Please note a special sampling event on the sample custody form.
