Sample Type is used to indicate whether the sample was a grab (G) or whether it was a composite (C).

Sample Matrix is used to indicate whether the sample is being discharged to drinking water (DW), groundwater (GW), surface water (SW), fresh surface water (FSW), salt surface water (SSW), soil sediment (SDMNT), or sludge (SLDCL).

Container Type is used to indicate whether the container is plastic (P) or glass (G).

Sample Temp is the temperature of the sample at the time of collection. The maximum temperature during storage should be 4°C (41.8°F). Under "Preservative," list any preservatives that were added to the sample container.

1. Each bottle has a label identifying sample ID, preservative used, date and time of collection, sample type, client ID, and preservative for analysis.

2. The following information should be added to each bottle label after collection with preservative: check box, date and time of collection, sample's name or initials, and any field number or ID.

3. All bottles not containing preservative may be stored in a refrigerator prior to collection.

4. The client is responsible for documentation of the sampling event. Please note special sampling events on the sample custody form.
