Instructions:

1. Each bottle has a label identifying sample ID, preservative type, collection date, time, and parameters for analysis.

2. The following information should be added to each bottle label after collection with permanent black ink: Date and time of collection, sample's name or initials, and any field number or ID.

3. All bottles containing preservative may be filled with appropriate sample prior to collection.

4. The client is responsible for documenting all sampling events on the sample control form.

Sample Matrix: Is used to indicate whether the sample is being collected as drinking water (DW), groundwater (GW), surface water (SW), fresh surface water (FSW), saline surface water (SSW), soil, sediment (SDMT), or sludge (SLDG).

Container Type: Is used to indicate whether the container is plastic (P) or glass (G).

Sample must be refrigerated or stored in ice after collection. The maximum temperature during storage should be 6°C (42.8°F). Under "Preservative," list any preservatives that were added to the sample container.
