Potential Topics for Discussion (Suggested by Leads):

- Regional Council should provide framework to avoid duplicating efforts
- Regional councils should be used as forum to resolve the ownership of data loaded into STORET/WIN or other databases (e.g who owns the data? The collector? The lab that analyzed the data? The monitoring entity that's paying for collection?)
- Regional councils can be used as effort to decentralize or regionalize statewide data collection and analyses
- Decide the extent of each region (WMD boundaries may not be relevant).
- TMDL and BMAP monitoring concerns
- Identify cross-regional issues
- Address surface water vs. ground water regions (they *are* different)
- Identify needed or existing other coordination teams; ID critical folks in these entities.
- What types of support we can offer them (teleconference support, webinars, etc.)
