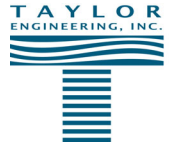

NOTICE TO ALL BIDDERS

1	The FDEP reserves the right to waive any informality in any bid, to reject any and all bids, and to delete any part of any of the above items.
2	Changes in the Contract Price and Contract Time require prior authorization in writing from the FDEP and the Engineer, in the form of a Change Order. The Contractor is responsible for verification of all bid quantities and to report to the Engineer any discrepancies found prior to ordering materials and or equipment for construction.
3	Bid prices for the various work items are intended to establish a total price for completing the project in its entirety. The Contractor shall include in the Bid, any item for which a separate pay item has not been established in the Bid Form (under any related pay item), to reflect the total price for completing the project in its entirety.
4	Quantities shown are estimated. Actual quantities may vary.
4	Contractor shall meet requirements of all applicable authorizations, permits and codes (in their current edition).
5	The FDEP will award the bid to the lowest qualified bidder.
