Failure to do so may be grounds for rejection of the Bid.

The following statements supersede & supplement the corresponding items in the specifications & drawings:

- 1. Question:** Can the EOR provide pile lengths so then all contractors are compared as apples to apples? It states 12' below mudline.
Answer: Piles shall be a minimum of 25 feet. Where weathered limestone is encountered, the Contractor should anticipate cutting excess piling off to achieve the grade elevation of the existing boardwalk.
Also: The Contractor shall anticipate pre-drilling the pile locations as there may be unknown obstructions not identified in the limited geotechnical borings.
- 2. Question:** In General Notes – Sheet G102 – Concrete Piles – 1. Piles Shall be 14 inch square FDOT prestressed concrete per FDOT Index 455-014/ Sheet S301 – Detail 1, 2, and 3 all denotes a 12" square FDPT prestressed concrete piles – can the client specify which is required?
Answer: The pile shall be 12" square FDOT piles. Commercial Piles not meeting FDOT Criteria will not be accepted.

In all other respects, the contract documents of which this is an Addendum, and attachments relative thereto, shall remain in full force and effect.
