Symbol	Type	Definition
	Accessible Amenity	Area or facility designed to be accessible for visitors of all abilities, including ADA-compliant features.
	Amphitheater/Stage	Outdoor venue for performances, presentations, or events.
	Bathhouse	Building with restrooms, showers, and changing areas for visitor use.
	Beach	Sandy or shoreline area along a body of water.
	Biking Trail	Trail designated for bicycle use.
	Biking/Equestrian Trail	Shared-use trail for bicycling and horseback riding.
	Birding	Area known for birdwatching opportunities.
	Boat Ramp	Improved ramp providing access for launching boats into the water.
	Boat Tours	Guided tours conducted via boat.
	Boating	Area designated for recreational boating.
	Cabins	Enclosed lodging units available for overnight stays.
	Campfire Circle	Structured seating area around a central fire pit, often for programs.
	Camping (Boat)	Overnight boatslips.
	Camping (Developed Group)	Improved campsites designed for organized groups with amenities.
	Camping (Equestrian)	Campsites with facilities for visitors traveling with horses.
	Camping (Full-Facility)	Campsites with full hookups (water, electric, sewer).
	Camping (Primitive Group)	Campsites designated for groups without full amenities.
	Camping (Primitive)	Undeveloped campsites with minimal or no facilities.
	Canoe/Kayak Launch	Designated launch point for canoes and kayaks.
	Canoeing/Kayaking	Area suitable for paddling activities.
	Concession	Facility offering food, drinks, or rental items.
	Dock/Pier	Structure for tying up boats or a raised walkway over water.
	Dump Station	Facility for safely disposing of RV wastewater.
	Environmental Education Center	Facility focused on environmental learning and exhibits.
	Equestrian Trail	Trail designated for horseback riding.
	Exercise/Jogging Trail	Trail designed for walking, jogging, or fitness activities.
	Family Reunions	Area designated or reservable for large family gatherings.
	Fishing	Area designated for recreational fishing.
	Fort	Historic military structure or site.
	Garden	Cultivated area with plants for display or conservation.
	Gazebo	Open-sided structure providing shade and seating.
	Geo-Seeking	Area suitable for geocaching activities.
	Hiking Trail	Trail designated for foot travel.
	Hiking/Biking Trail	Shared-use trail for hiking and biking.

	Hiking/Biking/Equestrian Trail	Shared-use trail for hiking, biking, and horseback riding.
	Hiking/Equestrian Trail	Shared-use trail for hiking and horseback riding.
	Historic Site	Location with historical significance.
	Kiosk/Interpretive Exhibit	Display providing educational or directional information.
	Laundry	Coin- or fee-operated washers and dryers for visitor use.
	Lighthouse	Tower with a light used as a navigational aid.
	Lodge	Full-service lodging facility.
	Marina	Facility providing boat docking, fuel, and related services.
	Meetings/Retreats	Facility or area for group meetings or retreats.
	Monument	Structure commemorating a person or event.
	Mountain Biking Trail	Trail or area specifically designed for off-road cycling.
	Museum	Facility displaying historical, cultural, or natural artifacts.
	Nature/Interpretive Trail	Trail featuring educational signage about natural or cultural resources.
	Observation Tower	Area designated for observing wildlife.
	Park Office or Administration	Administrative office location.
	Paddling Trail	Marked water route for canoeing or kayaking.
	Parking	Designated area for vehicle parking.
	Pets	Area where pets are permitted, typically with restrictions.
	Picnic Area	Designated area with tables for picnicking.
	Picnic Pavilion	Covered structure with tables for group picnicking.
	Playground	Area with equipment for children's play.
	Ranger Station	Facility where park rangers are based.
	Recycling	Recycling collection point.
	Restroom	Public restroom facility available for general use.
	Roller Blading	Area suitable for inline skating.
	Scuba Diving	Area suitable for scuba diving.
	Shelling	Area where collecting seashells is common or permitted.
	Shower Station	Facility providing showers, often near beaches or campgrounds.
	Snorkeling	Area suitable for surface underwater viewing.
	Star Gazing	Area suitable for observing the night sky.
	Surfing	Area designated for wave surfing.
	Swimming	Designated swimming area in natural water.
	Swimming Pool	Maintained pool for swimming.
	Tours	Organized guided tours for visitors.
	Trailhead	Designated starting point for one or more trails, often with signage and maps.
	Tubing	Area suitable for floating on inner tubes.
	Visitor/Interpretive Center	Main visitor facility with exhibits, staff, and information.
	Water Fountain	Fixed fountain providing potable drinking water.
	Weddings	Area designated or reservable for wedding ceremonies.
	Wildlife Viewing	Area specifically known for observing wildlife.
