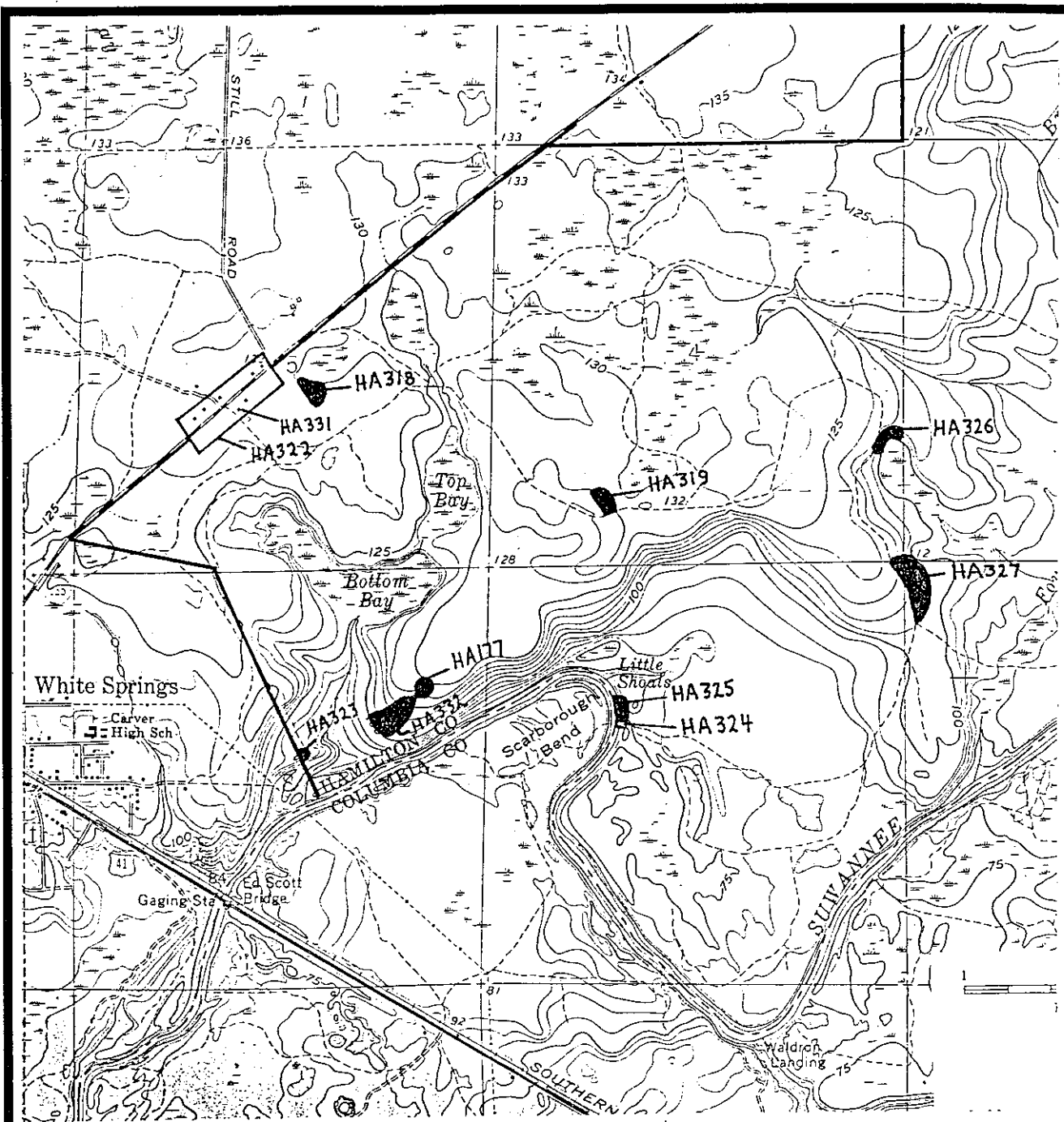
SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION

This site is a thin scatter of coral flakes and shatter present around the Hawthorn Formation outcrop at Little Shoals. Material is primarily present at the second and third set of shoals, north of 8HA324. Diagnostic artifacts were not found, though may be present.
