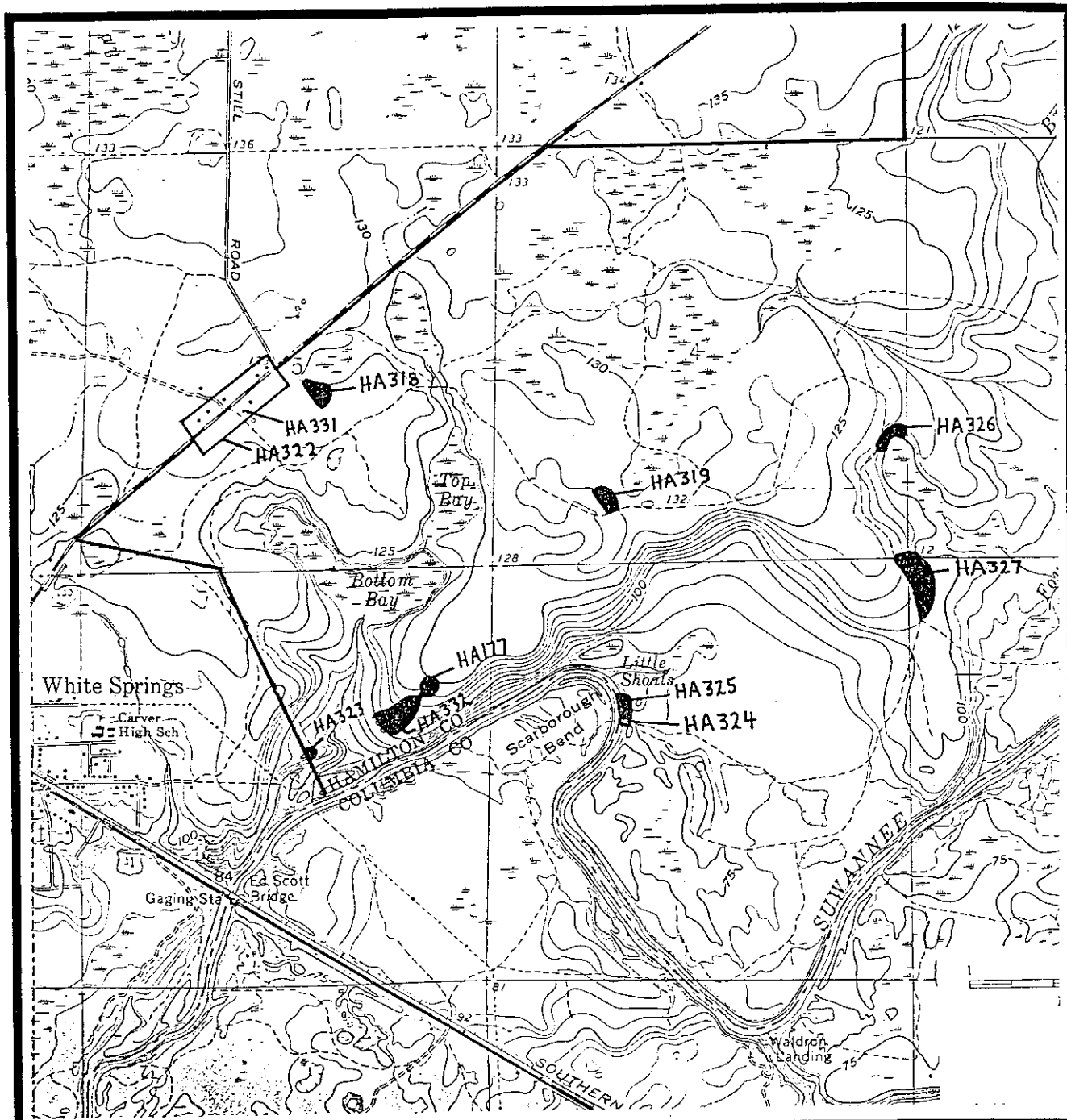
SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION

This site is composed of a thin scatter of coral and chert flakes mixed with Herty cup fragments and other historic debris. A large metal bolt and nut (railroad hardware?) were observed. No diagnostic artifacts were found, but some may be present. It also is likely that subsurface material is present.

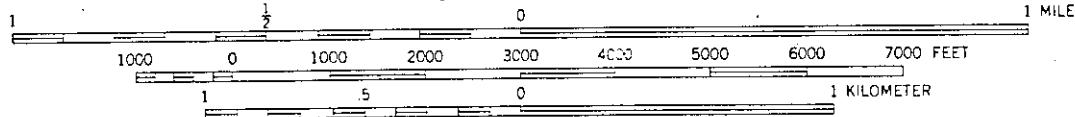
