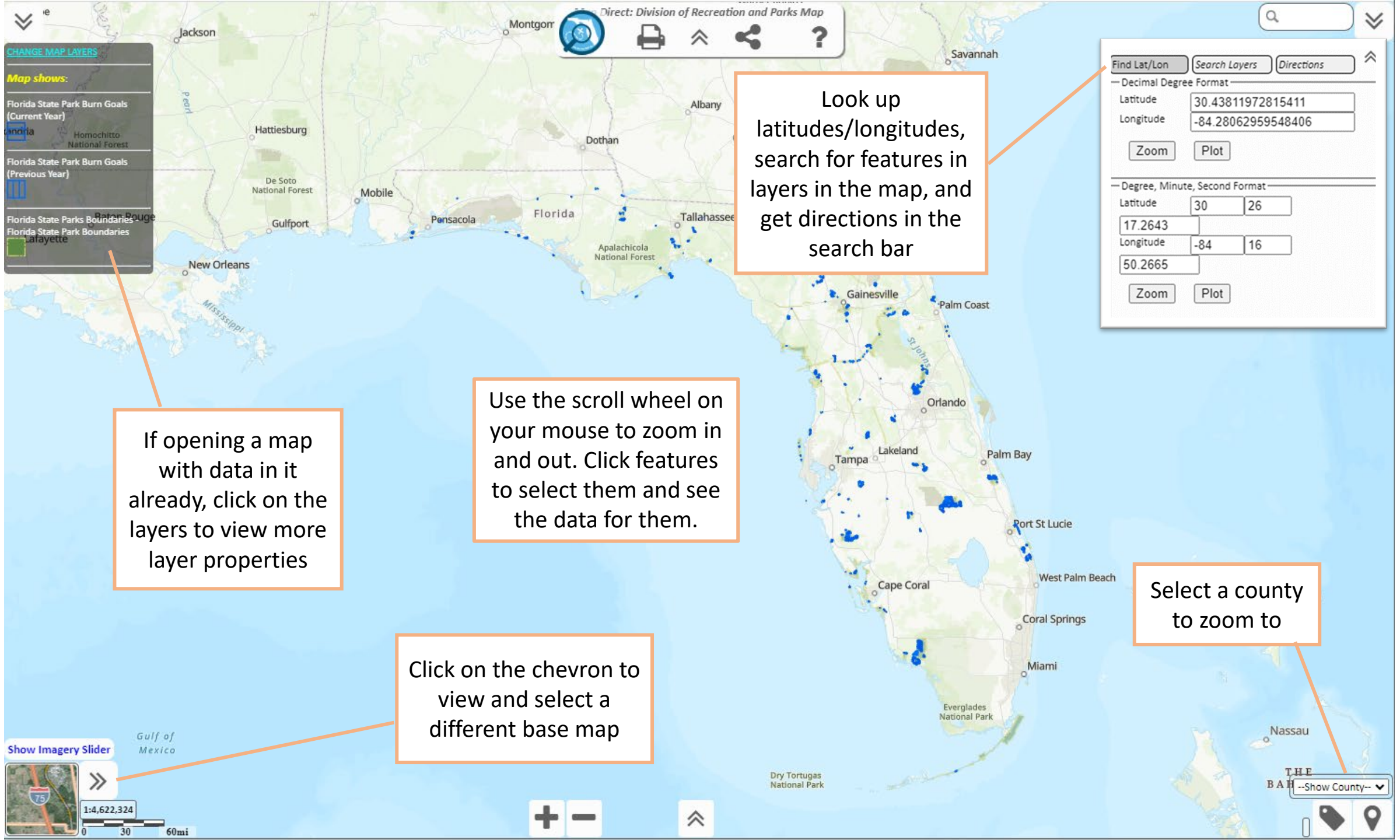

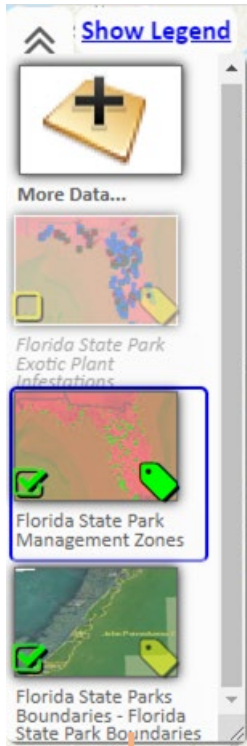

Change the field your label will be named by. For example, if you want to label natural communities by desired future condition instead of existing condition.

View a table of the data and download it as a spreadsheet or print it when needed

Add filters to narrow down the data that is visible in your map for that layer (next page)

Choose a field to filter on:

PARK_NAME

Alphanumeric (String) : Name of the park.

Exact Match Filter:

- Type a field value in the text box to show only that feature on the map
- You may include multiple values by separating them with a pipe |
- Click Get Samples to get sample values in a drop down. PLEASE NOTE - Internet Explorer may crash when trying to do this for fields with thousands of values
- You can choose a sample from the drop down to add it to the filter
- For String fields only - Check the 'Near Match' box to make the filter match any value containing the entered values. Example - 'Z2-SS-14' would match 'Z2-SS-14001' and 'Z2-SS-14199'
- Click Set Filter to apply the filter
- Click Cancel to abort

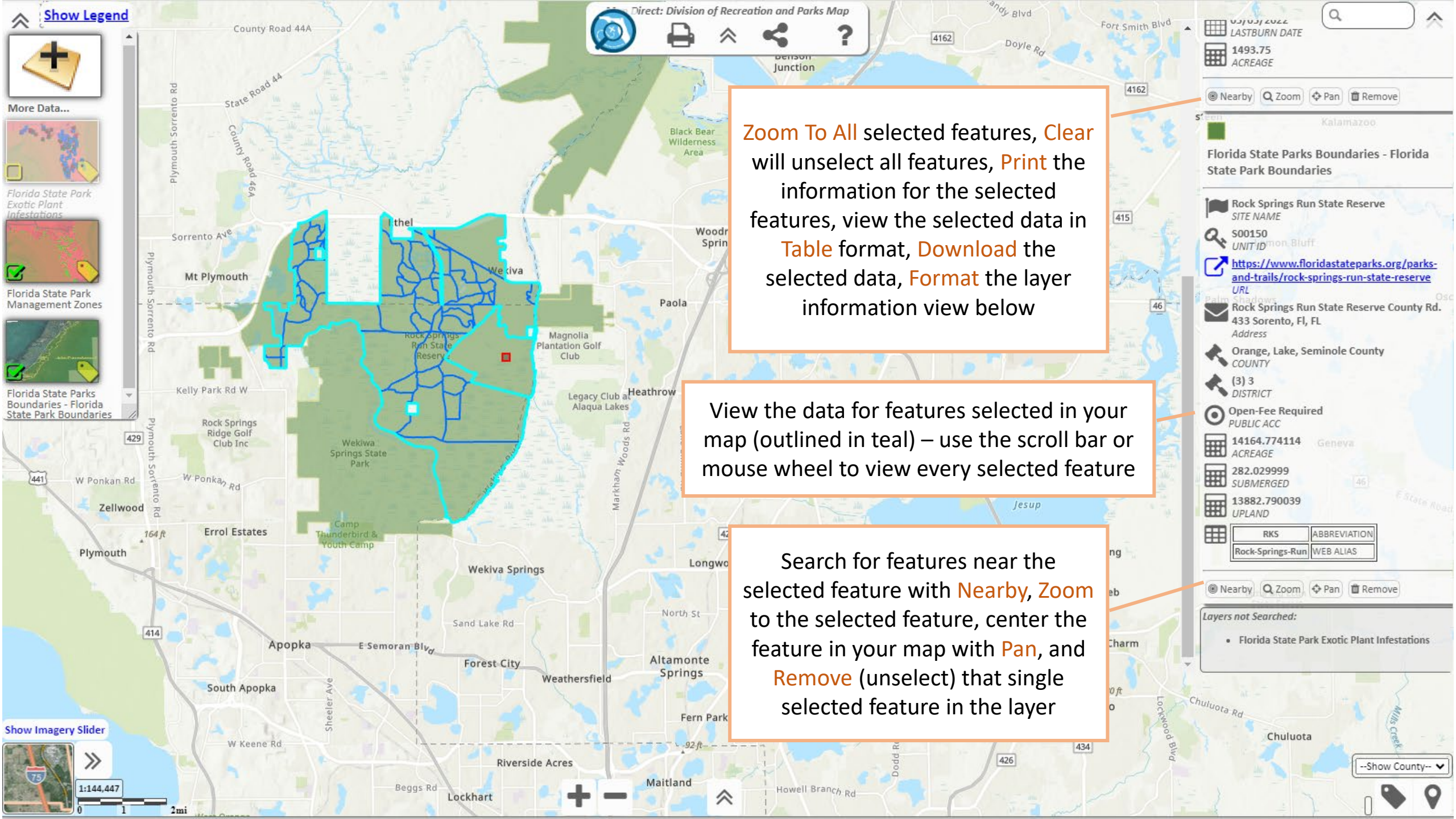

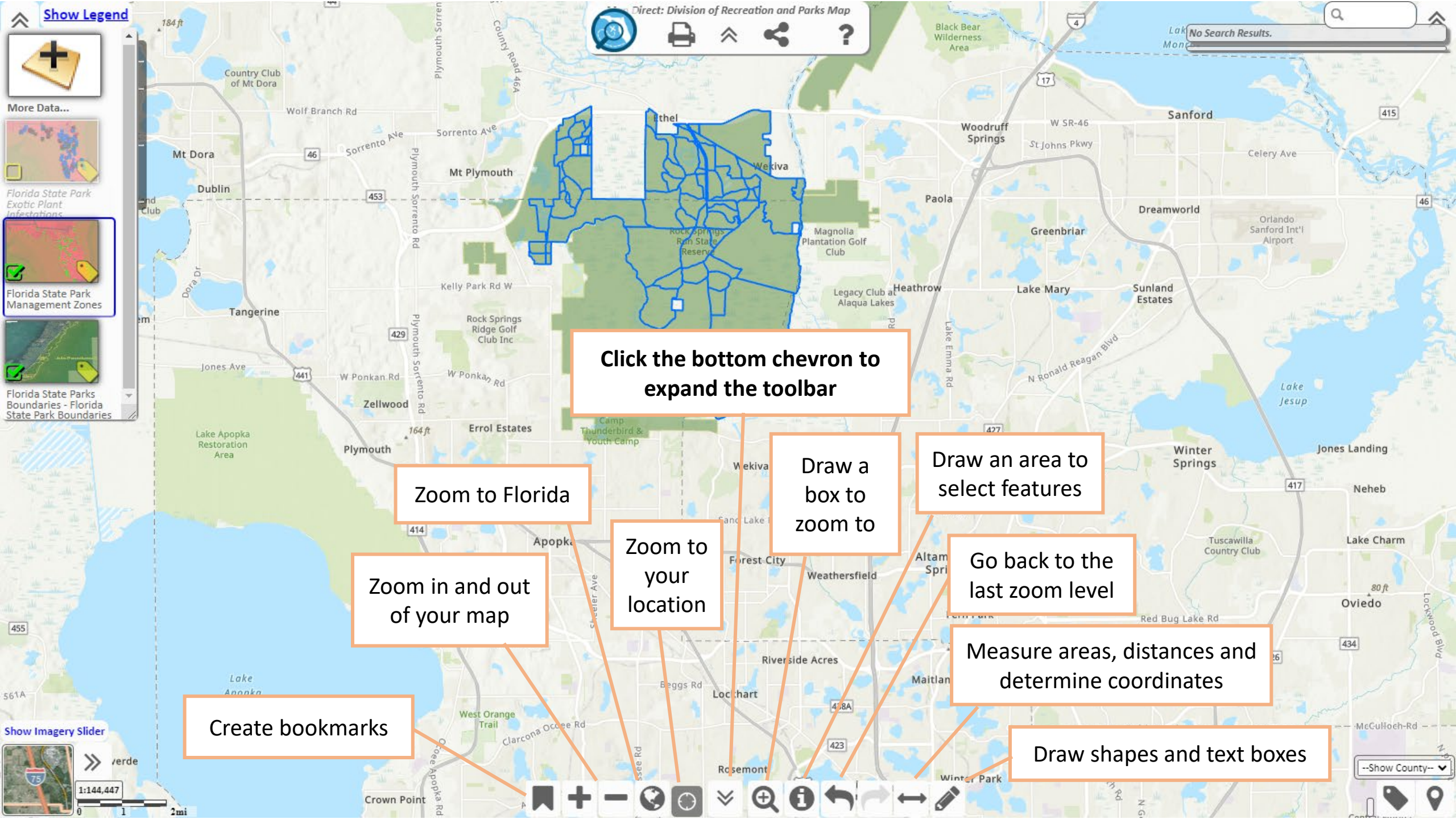
Click **Get Samples** to see the categories for that field

Other fields (filters not supported at this time for these types of fields)

- LASTBURN_DATE (esriFieldTypeDate)
- OBJECTID (esriFieldTypeOID)
- GEOMETRY (esriFieldTypeGeometry)

Filters can be very helpful if you only want to show data for a specific park or if you only wanted to show a specific type of invasive plants, etc.

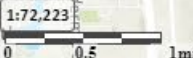

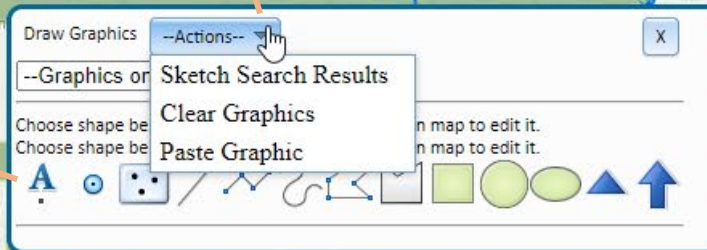

Gopher Tortoise Burrow

Click and drag a point to move it around the map – a buffered point (or other shape) will move independently from its buffer

Burn Area

Set the size of the buffer and choose the units and then click the **Buffer** button to create it

Choose the **Marker Style**, **Color**, **Size**, **Remove** that marker from your map or finish creating a marker with **Done**

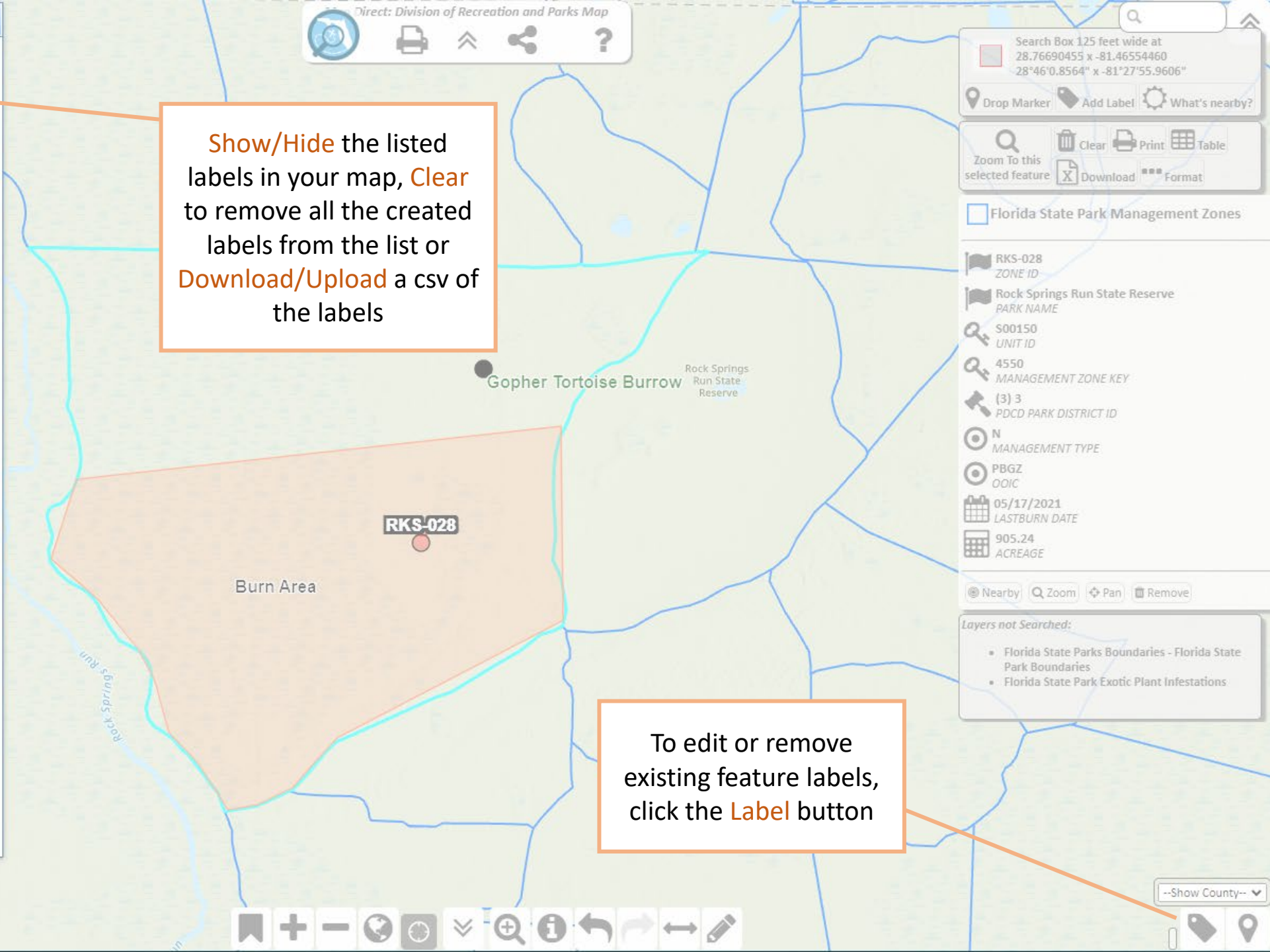

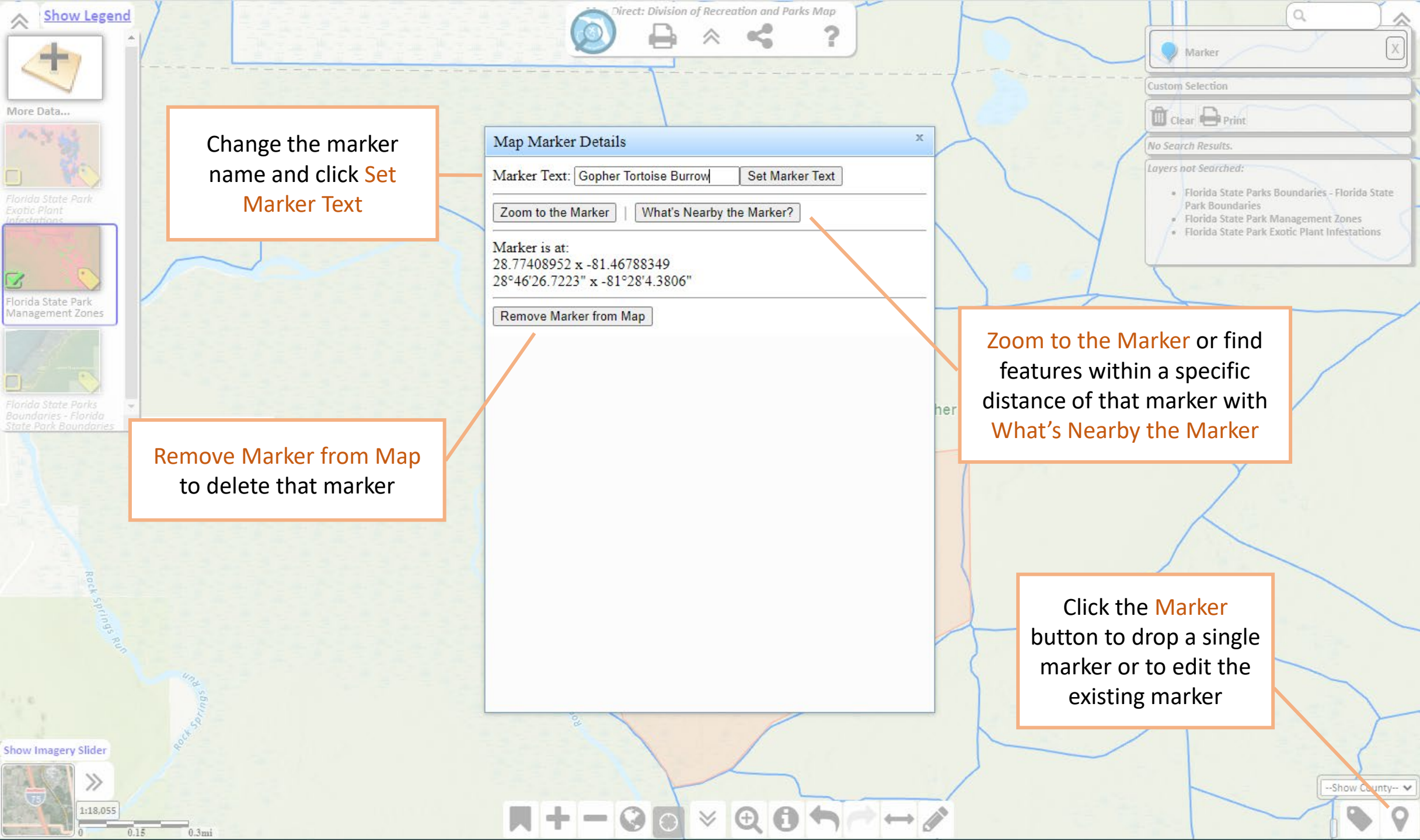

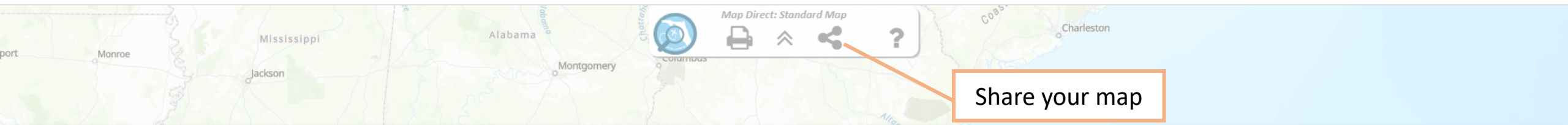

The pdf will include the map title, your map, date, a key, scale, notes and layer information. Click **Show Printable Legend** to have a separate page with just the legend. **The pdf that is generated is a GeoPDF that can be used in Avenza App!**

If you have an ArcGIS Online login, open it in AGO to have more options for symbology, labeling, etc.

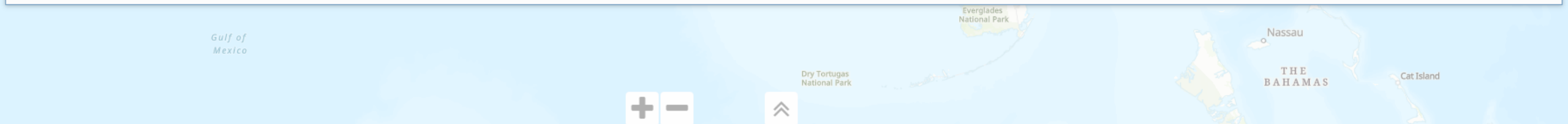

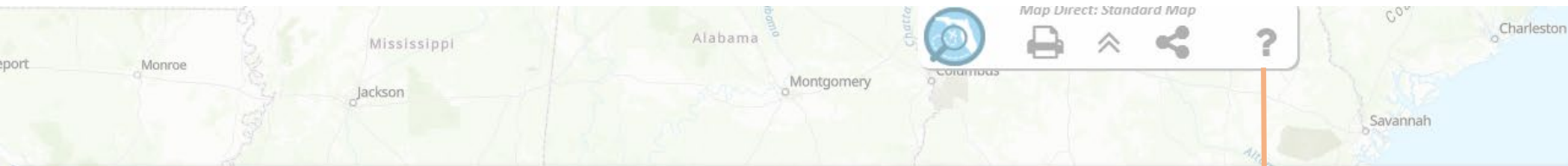
The tool will pop up a map in a new tab using the map link URL, so be sure to disable pop up blockers for .dep.state.fl.us.

Use your browser to bookmark the map link URL in the new tab, or copy the URL from the browser address bar.

**When a map is opened in ArcGIS Online, only the current extent and layers are preserved. Opacity, labels, filters, etc are not preserved in the ArcGIS Online map. Some layers may not function properly in ArcGIS Online.

Bookmark Map will save the URL of the map so you can share it with people or save it to return to later. When the new page opens, bookmark the page in your browser to be able to return to it later or copy and paste the URL to save it somewhere else. This will save the layers in your map as well as shapes, labels, etc.
