

Creating a Geographic Location (Lat/Long) Training Video Transcript

To create a Geographic Location (lat/long) for a General Disposal or Processing Record, select the Classes tab, and double click the specific Class you need to update.

Click the Geographic Location tab and select Create Record.

WACS will generate a Geographic Location based on the lat/long coordinates created with the original Facility Record.

Click Launch/Populate GIS. This will open WebShapeLite, which allows you to verify or visually relocate the lat/long.

If the lat/long is in an accurate position, select Return Shape Edits.

If you wish to move this point to a new position, you can locate it by moving the map in any direction and zooming in and out using the mouse wheel. You can also reference the Instructions for more detail.

Once you locate the correct position, left click on the point, and select Return Shape Edits.

Select OK and click Launch/Populate GIS a second time.

Note that the lat/longs have been updated, and all verification fields have been populated. You can update information that is not accurate. For example, since this location was positioned at the entrance of the facility, the Proximity to Object should be updated.

Once you select Commit Changes, a Geographic Location for the General Disposal or Processing Record has been created.
