

Updating Geographic Location (Lat/Long) Using WebShape Lite Training Video Transcript

This video will demonstrate how to update a Geographic Location (lat/long) using WebShapeLite, a tool that allows you to visually move a record's location.

Click the Geographic Locations tab, and double click on the record you need to update.

Click Launch/Populate GIS. This will open WebShapeLite, which allows you to verify and visually relocate the lat/long.

This will show you the current location of the record. To locate the correct position, you can move the map in any direction, and zoom in and out using the mouse wheel. You can also reference the Instructions for more detail.

Once you find the correct location, left click on the point, and select Return Shape Edits.

Select OK and click Launch/Populate GIS a second time.

Note that the lat/longs and the Coordinate Method have been updated, and all verification fields have been populated.

If Proximity to Object is blank or needs updating, use the List of Values.

If Collecting Environmental Interest is blank or needs updating, use the List of Values to select Solid Waste Management.

Once you select Commit Changes, the Geographic Location for the General Disposal or Processing Record has been updated.

Exit back to the Facility Information screen to update any remaining Geographic Location records and repeat the process for each.
