As the lead agent implementing the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA) response program, the Army National Guard G9 in coordination with the Florida Army National Guard, formally transmits the Final Preliminary Assessment reports for the Camp Blanding Joint Training Center, Florida; Marianna Readiness Center, Marianna, Florida; Brooksville Readiness Center/Army Aviation Support Facility #2, Spring Hill, Florida; Cecil Field Army Aviation Support Facility, Jacksonville, Florida; Dade City Readiness Center, Dade City, Florida; Fort Pierce Readiness Center, Fort Pierce, Florida; Lakeland Readiness Center, Lakeland, Florida; Plant City Readiness Center, Plant City, Florida and Ellyson Field, Pensacola, Florida, for your records. These Preliminary Assessment reports and subsequent Site Inspections are a product of the Army National Guard program for responding to Perfluorooctane Sulfonic Acid (PFOS) and Perfluorooctanoic Acid (PFOA) impacted sites at Army National Guard installations nationwide.

Based on the results of the Preliminary Assessments, Site Inspections will be conducted at Camp Blanding Joint Training Center, Marianna Readiness Center, Brooksville Readiness Center/Army Aviation Support Facility #2 and Cecil Field Army Aviation Support Facility. The Dade City Readiness Center, Fort Pierce Readiness Center, Lakeland Readiness Center, Plant City Readiness Center and Ellyson Field requires no further action. Draft Final Site Inspection Uniform Federal Policy-Quality Assurance Project Plan Addenda for these facilities, with the exception of Dade City Readiness Center, Fort Pierce Readiness Center, Lakeland Readiness Center, Plant City Readiness Center and Ellyson Field, will be transmitted at a later date and Technical Project Planning meetings will be scheduled with you for those Site Inspections.
