NOTES: **To the full extent permitted by law, all buildings and structures which are located or constructed on property in the Greater Edgewater Water, Wastewater and Reclaimed Water Service Area and which are adjacent to a public right-of-way or easement that has a water main or gravity sanitary wastewater located in it, are required to connect with and use the services and facilities of the city water and wastewater systems. Any properties with wells or septic tanks must connect to system when those fail, and wells must be destroyed.**
